

CHAPTER VIII

ANALYSIS

The analysis helps provide answer to the primary and secondary research questions. The issues of data analysis has included:

Summarization of Data.

1. Primary outcome.

The primary outcome of the study, the pattern of health services utilization, has been summarized as follows:

- 1.1 <u>Curative service</u>. The utilization of curative service has been summarized in term of <u>proportion</u>, calculated from cases utilizing curative service per the total illnesses cases.
- 1.2 <u>Maternal and child care health services.</u> The outcome which is measured in term of number of cases receiving the services has been summarized in term of the <u>proportion</u> of those persons seeking each service per population in need.

2. Secondary outcome.

The data on associated factors have been summarized in term of means and proportions depending on the type of variables.

The univariate and multi-variate analysis have been performed for the study variables.

Statistical Analysis.

The statistical test are required to provide the answer to the secondary research questions for determining the factors influencing health services utilization. The multiple regression has been used to analyse the multiple variables and the prediction of health services utilization can be determined.

The statistical tests for this study can be summarized in Table 9.
