

MATERIAL AND METHOD

A study of Khon Kaen University Campus Flora was conducted from April 1975 to March 1976. The work was started with a general survey of the whole campus which are practically divided into zones. The undisturbed zonal areas selected for study are by names More-Din-Daeng, Dong-Wang and Sri-Tan. The general physiognomy of each zone was observed. Field trips were made in every season (not every month, some months were skipped) and the collection of specimens had been done in all studied zones. The introduced plants of ornamental value and for agricultural purpose were avoided. The distribution and species dominance were also recorded.

The collected specimens were then prepared and worked out for identification through literatures and comparison with the known specimens in the Two Thai Herbaria B.K. and P.K.F.. Such specimens are supposed to be deposited in the new Khon Kaen University Herbarium, B.K., P.K.F. and Herbarium of Chulalongkorn University.
