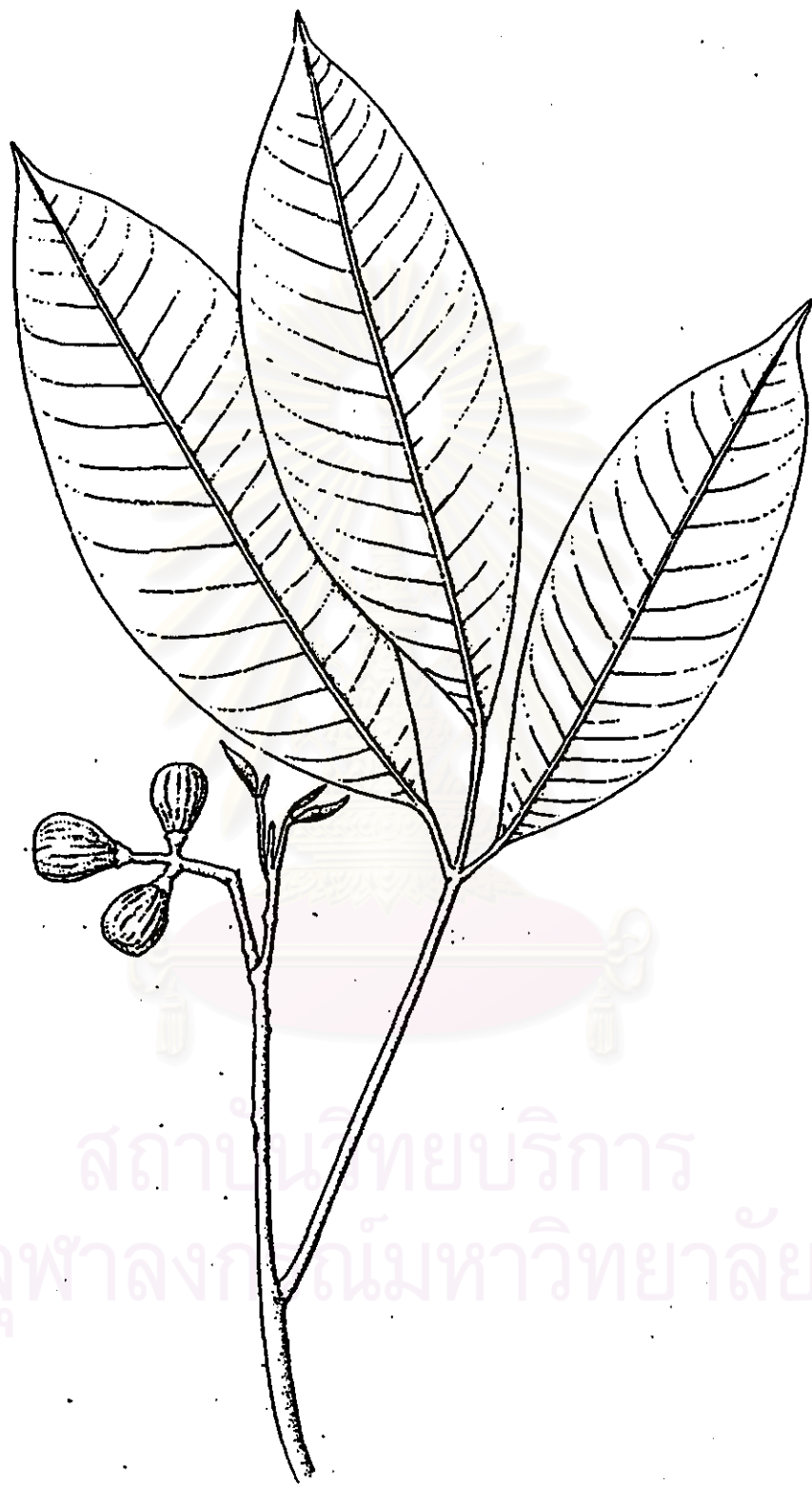


Figure 1 *Aglaia chittagonga* Miq.

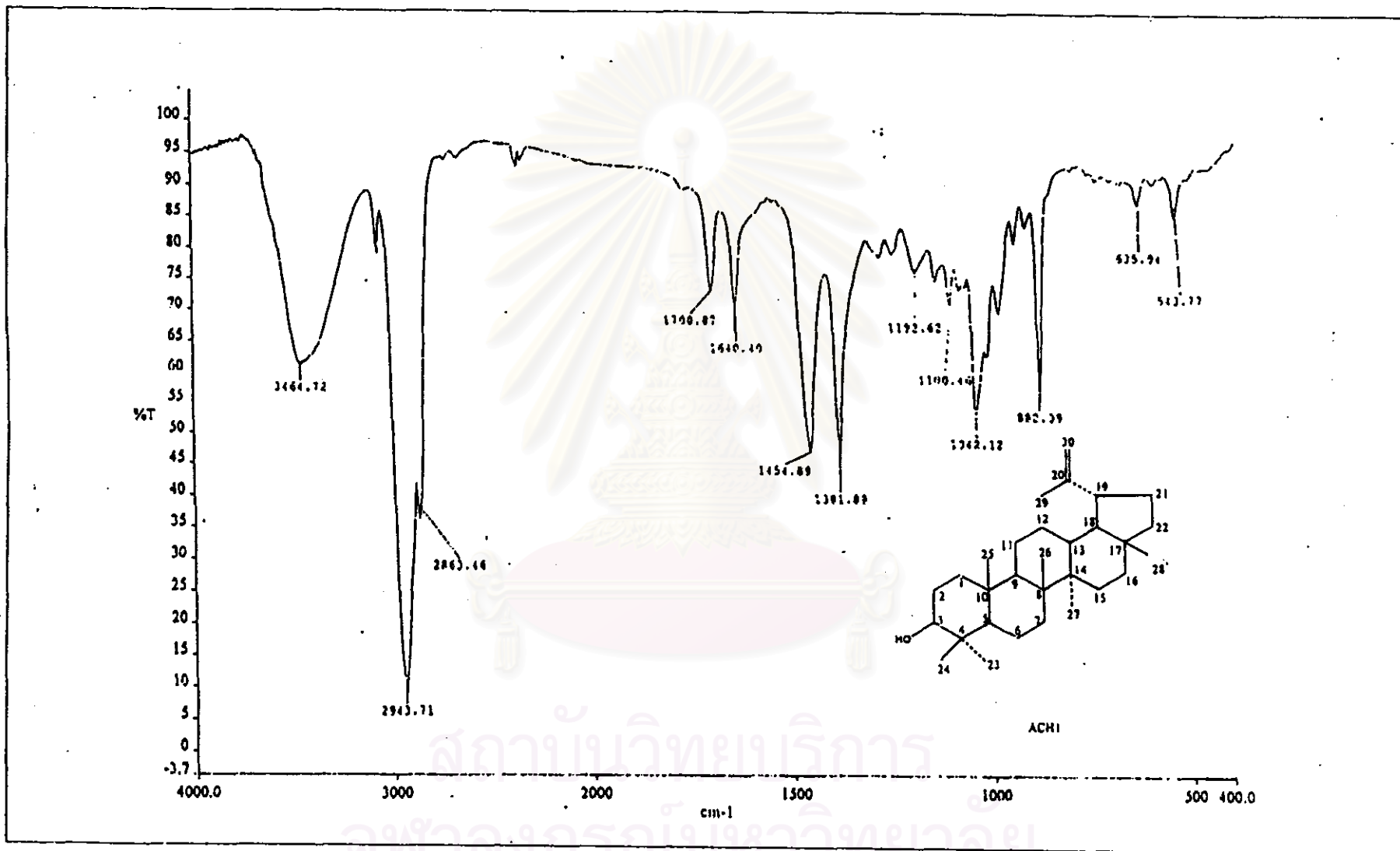


Figure 8 IR spectrum of compound ACH1 (KBr disc)

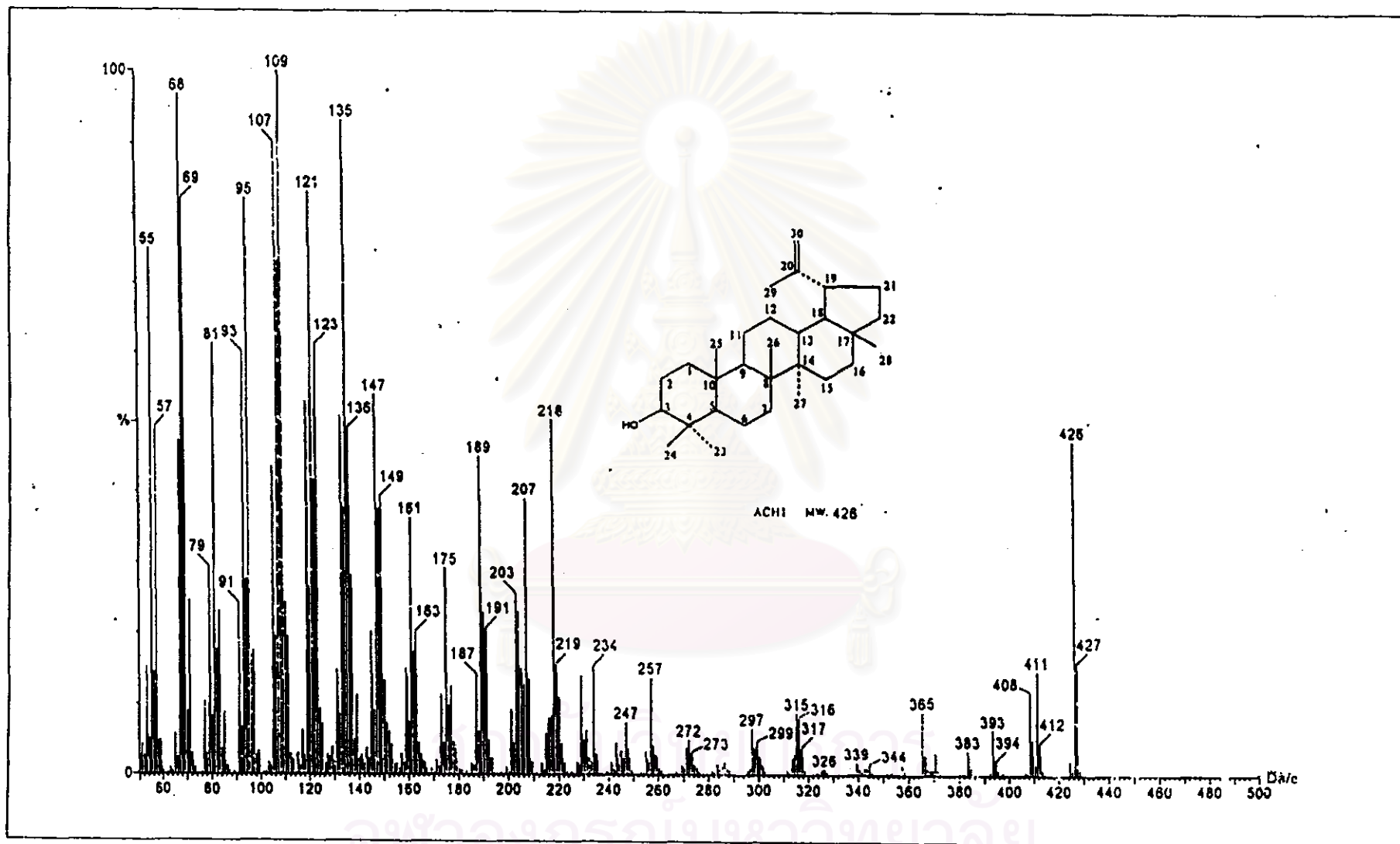


Figure 9 EIMS spectrum of compound ACH1

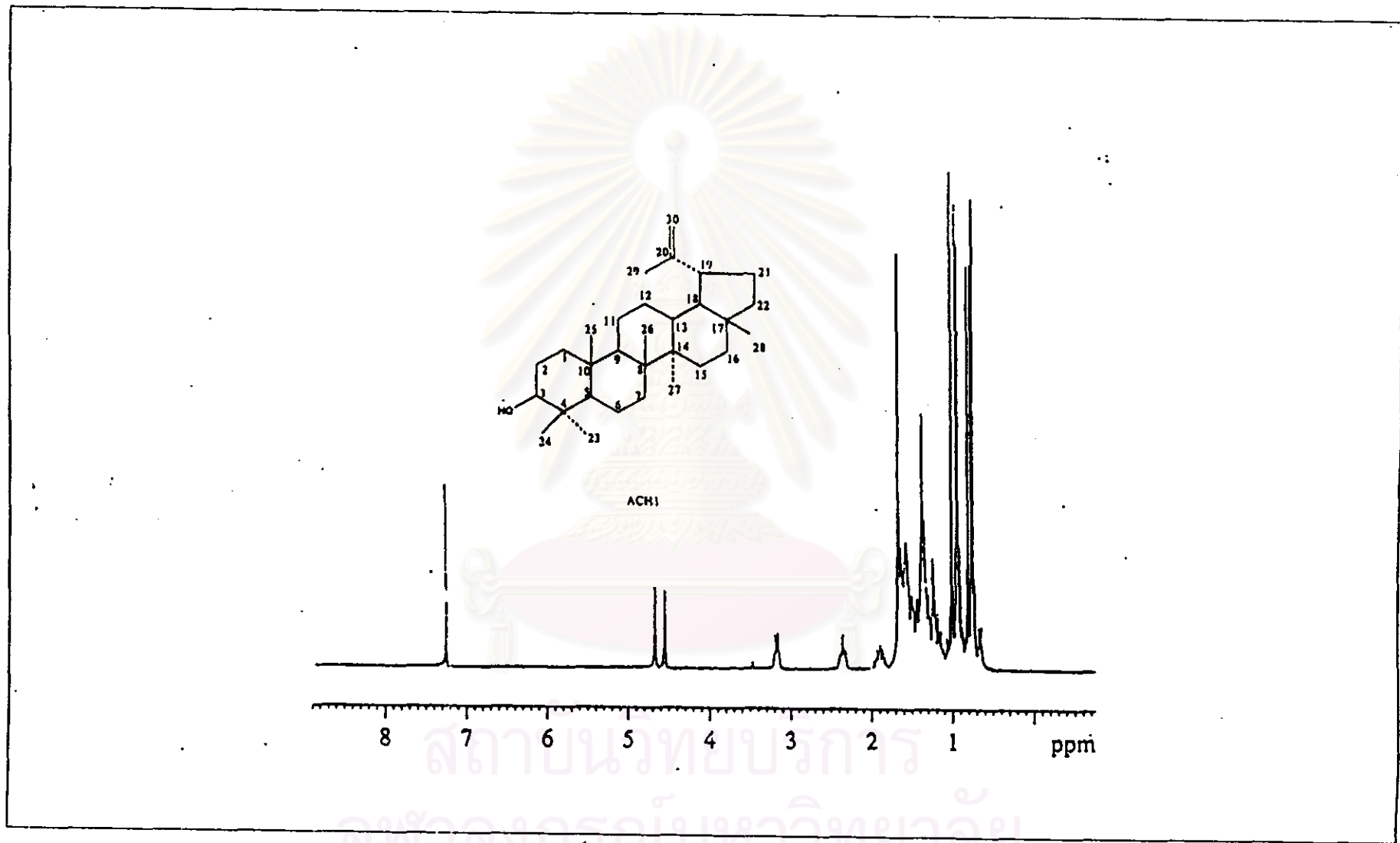


Figure 10 The 300 MHz ¹H NMR spectrum of compound ACH1 (in CDCl₃)

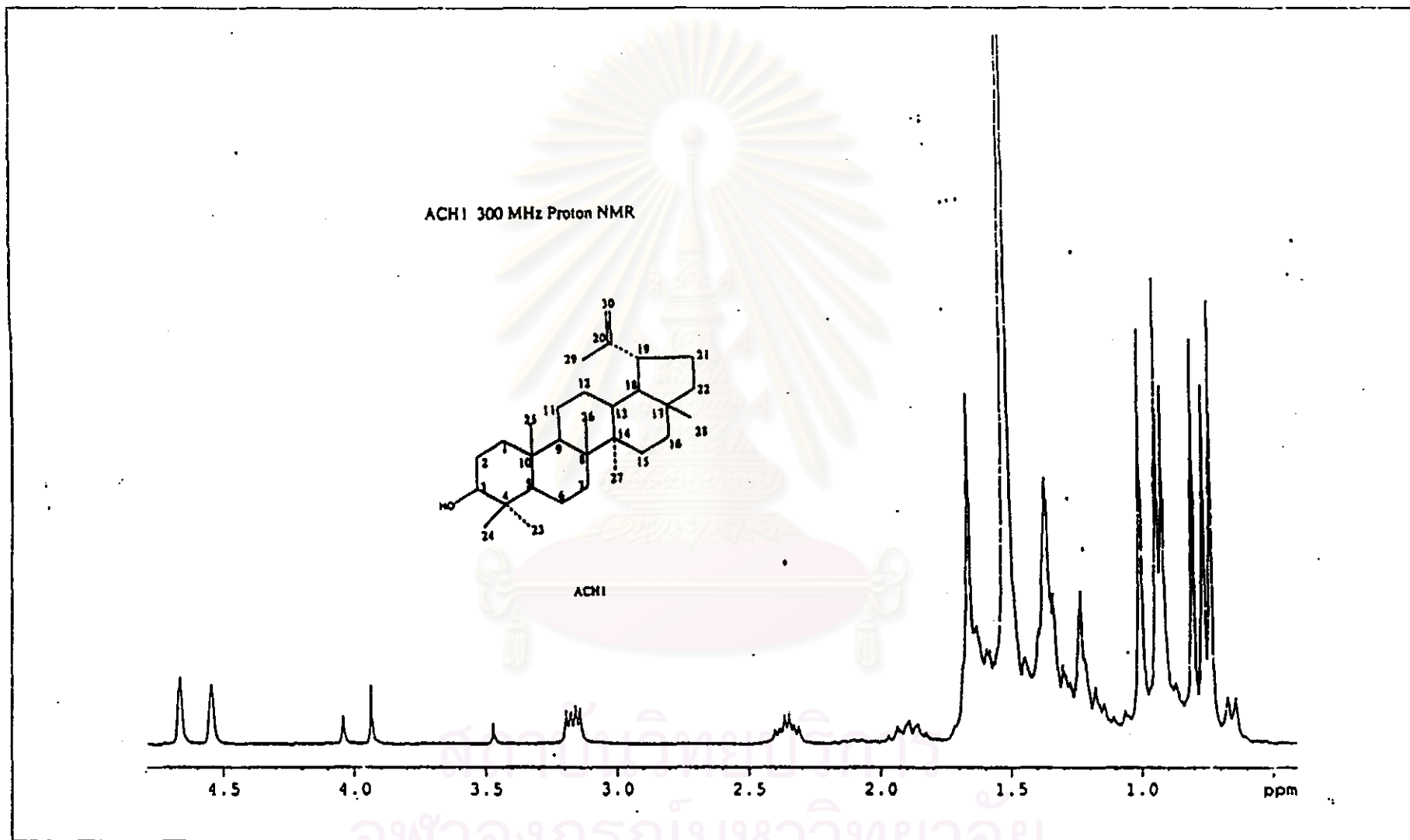


Figure 11 The 300 MHz ¹H NMR spectrum of compound ACH1 (in CDCl₃) (expanded in the range of δ0-5ppm)

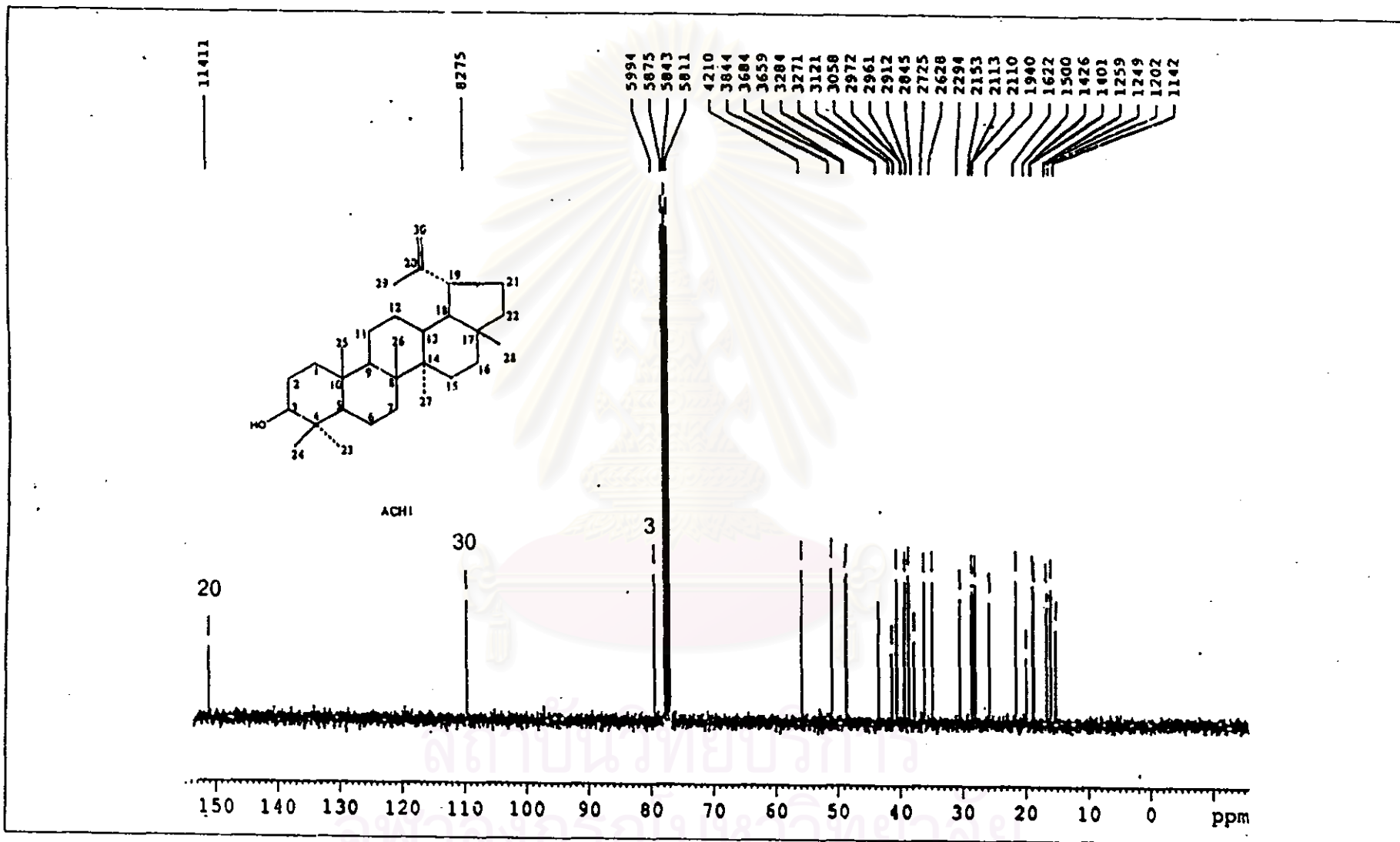


Figure 12 The 75 MHz ^{13}C NMR spectrum of compound ACH1 (in CDCl_3)

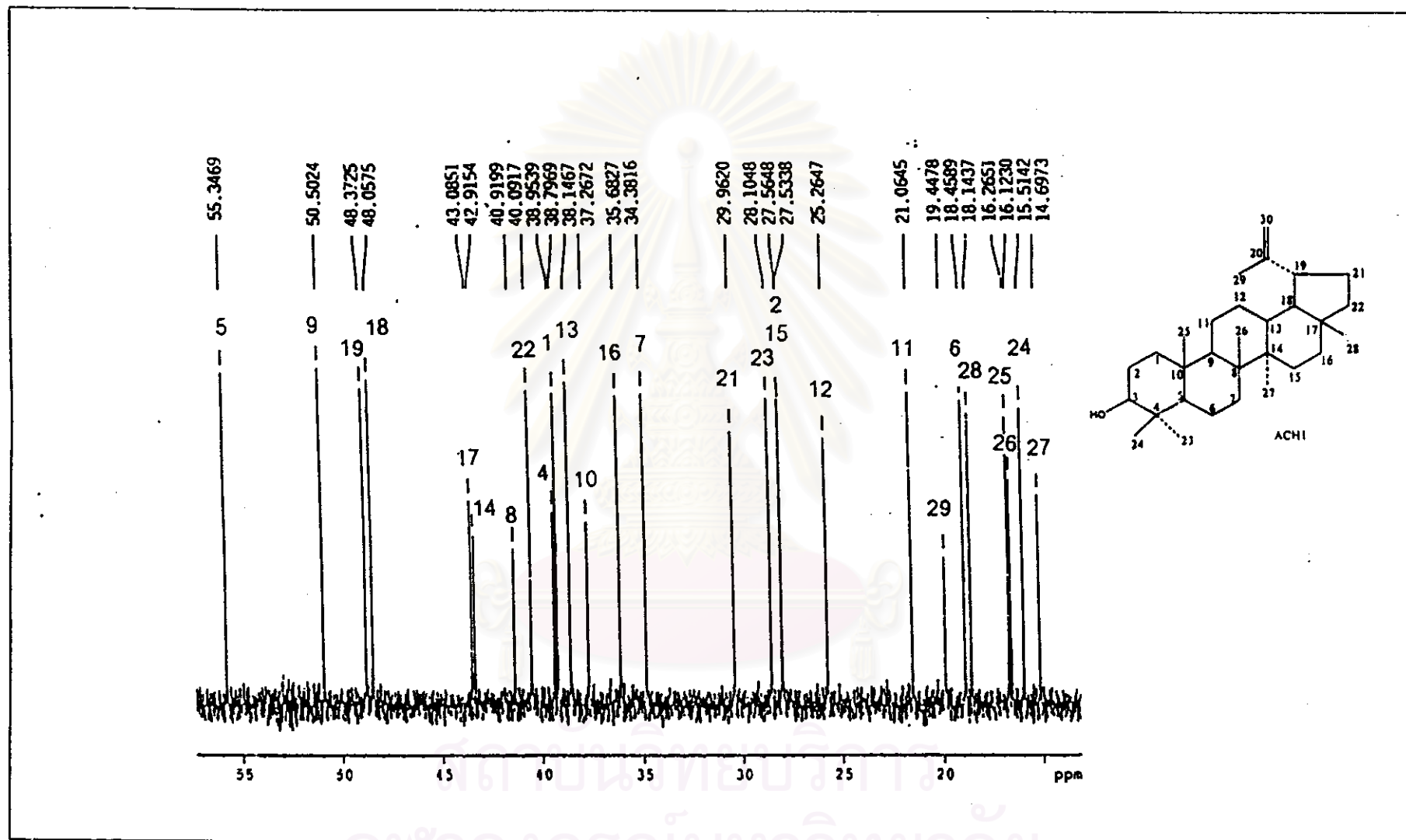


Figure 13 The 75 MHz ^{13}C NMR spectrum of compound ACH1(in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 0-60ppm)

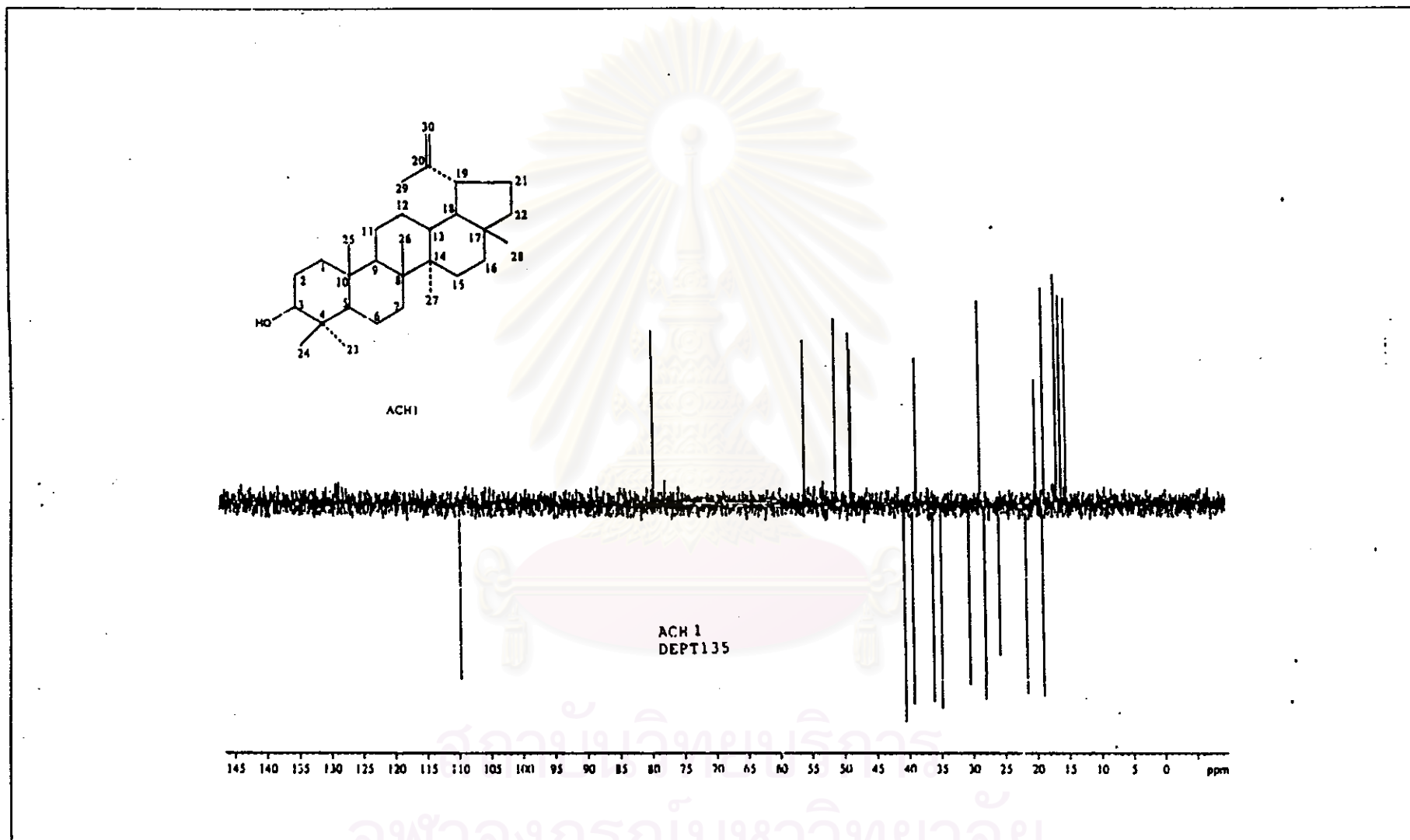


Figure 14 DEPT spectrum of compound ACH1(in CDCl₃)

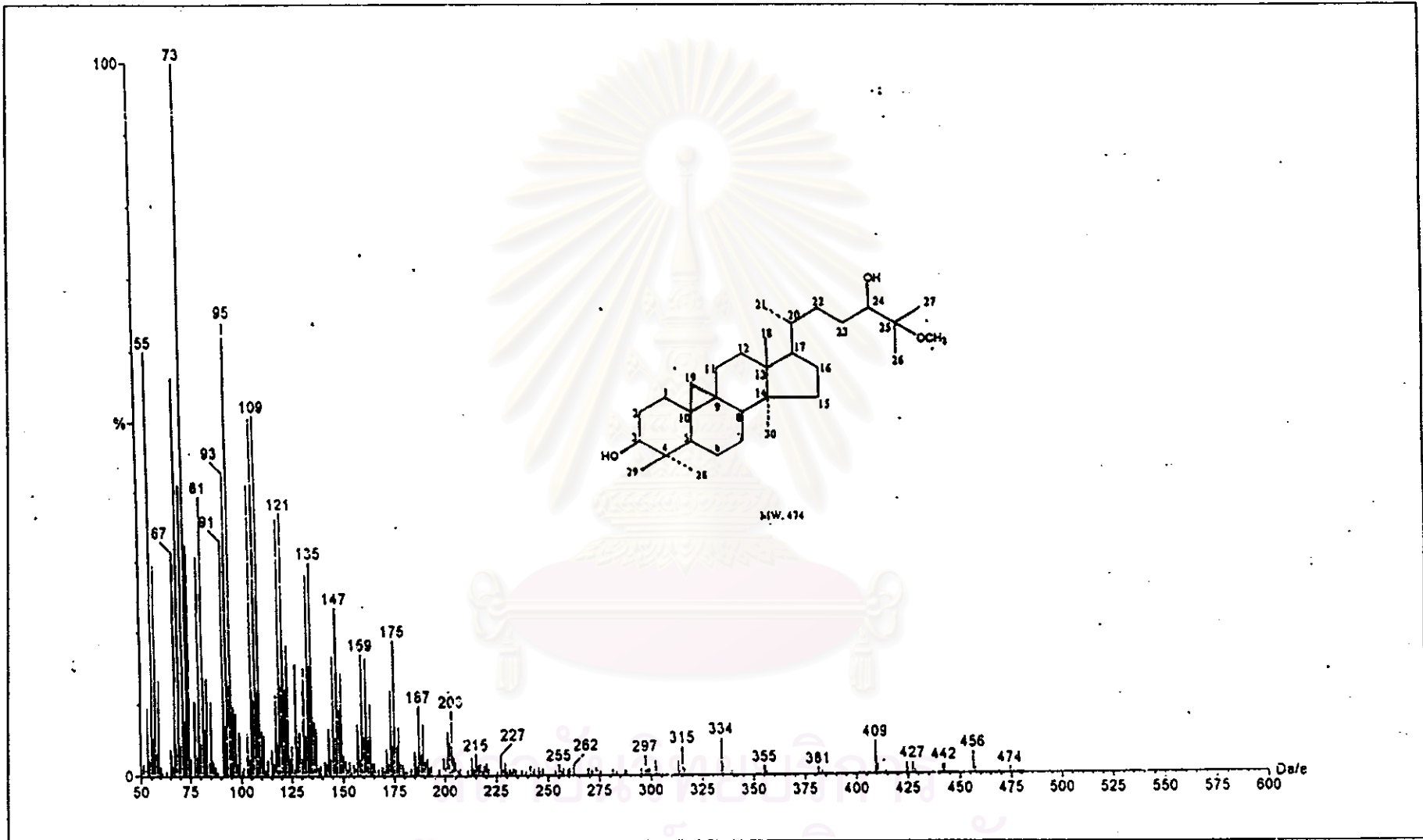


Figure 15 EIMS spectrum of compound ACH2

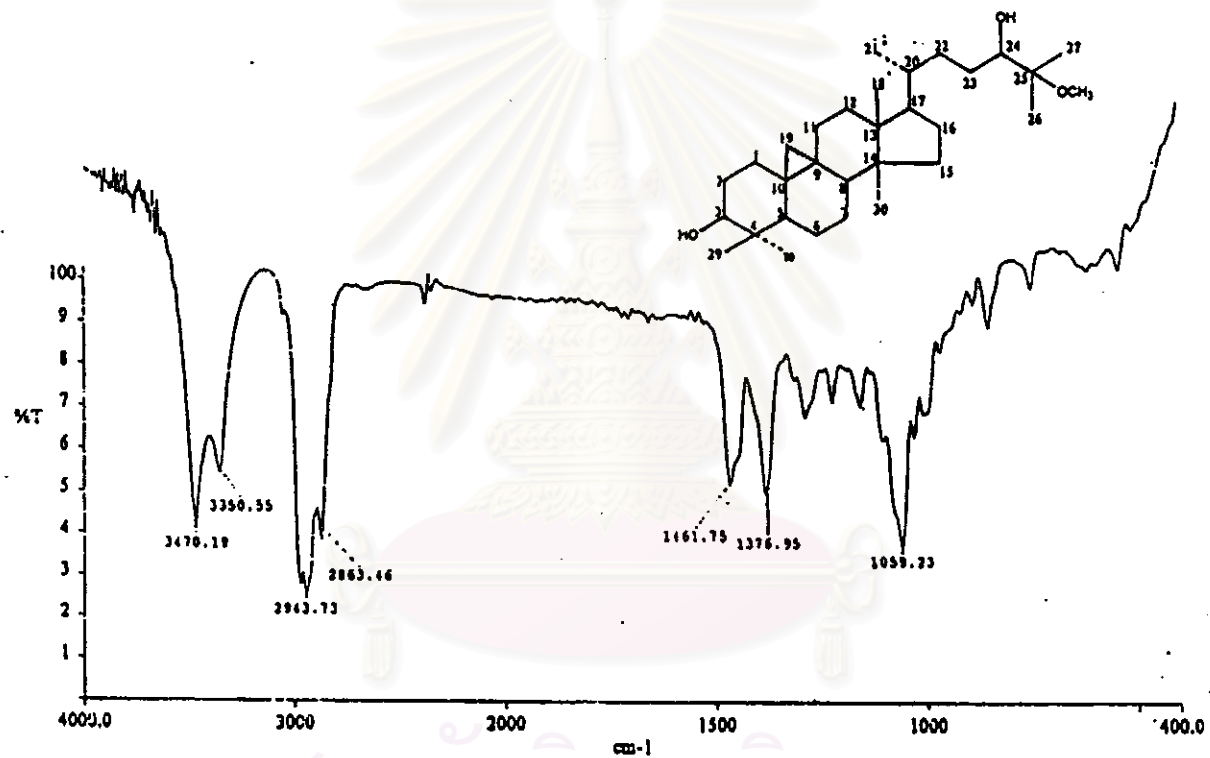


Figure 16 IR spectrum of compound ACH2 (KBr disc)

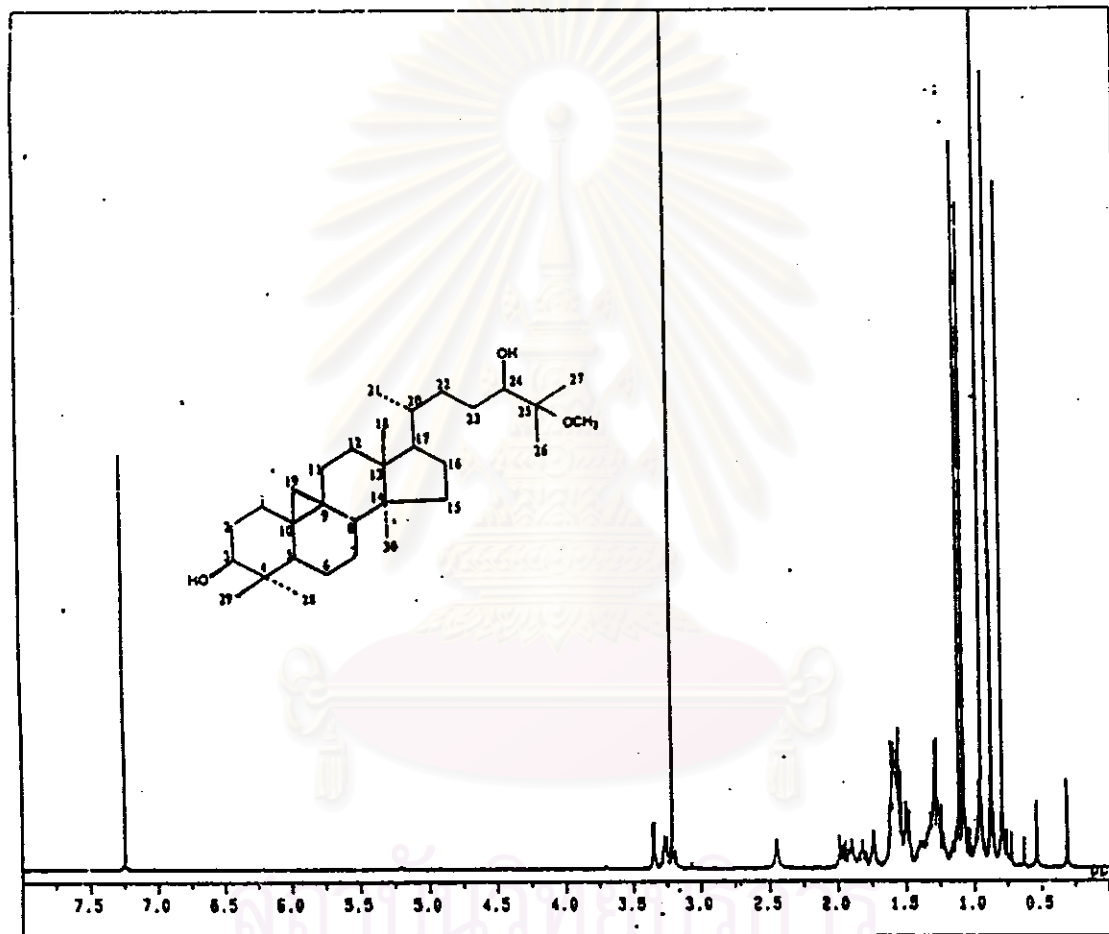


Figure 17 The 500 MHz ¹H NMR spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl₃)

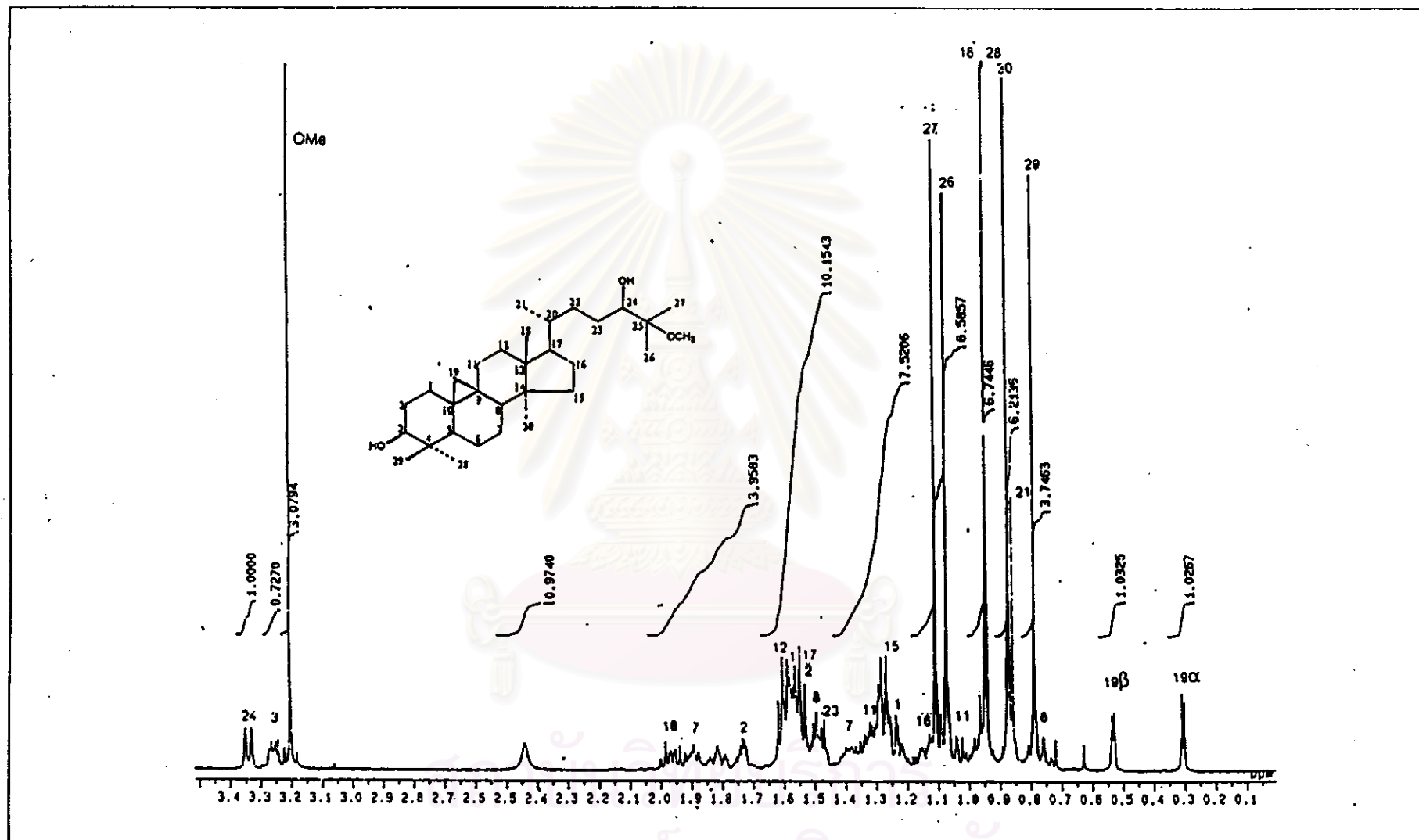


Figure 18 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 0-3.5 ppm)

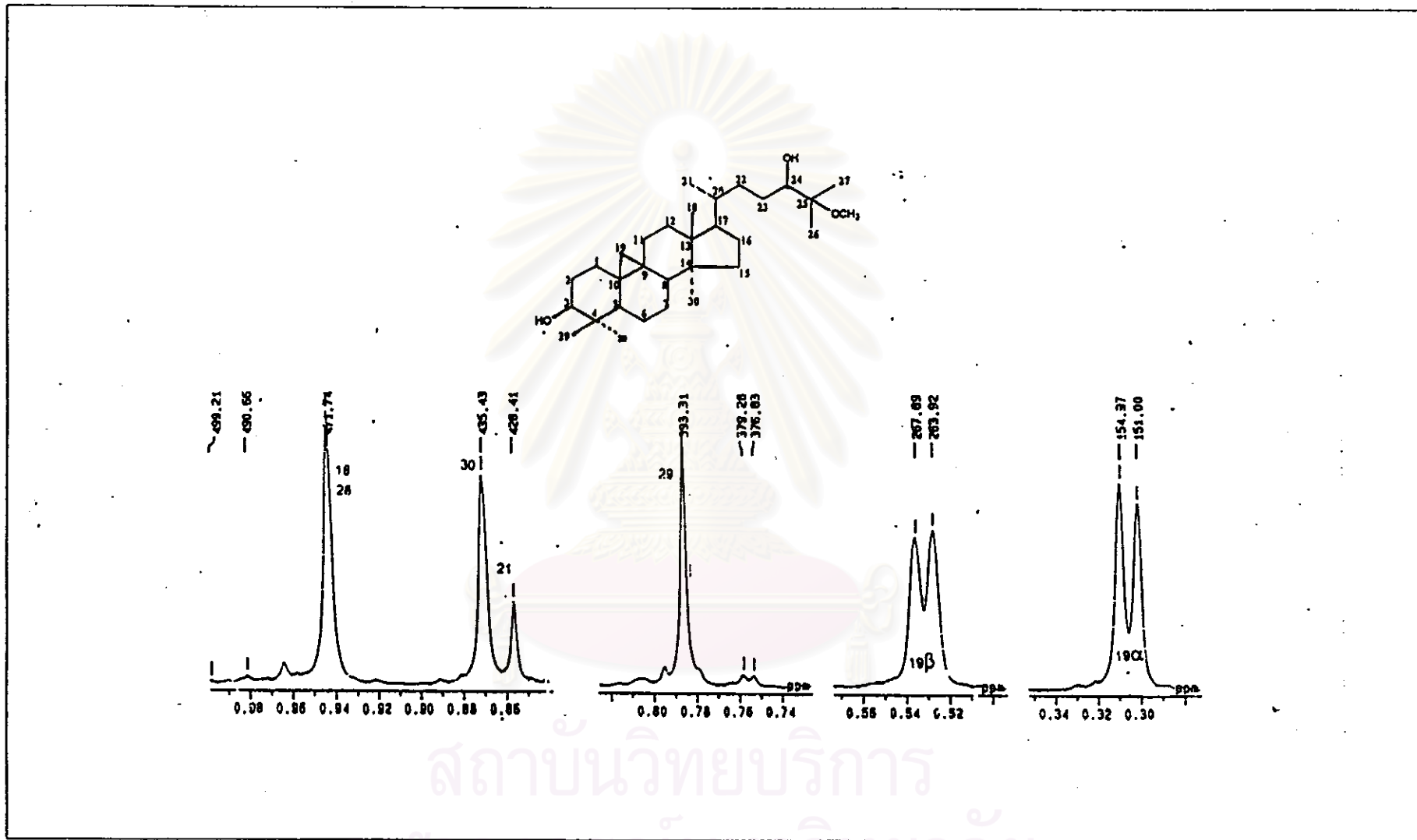


Figure 19 The 500 MHz ¹H NMR spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl₃) (expanded in the range of δ 0.3-0.98 ppm)

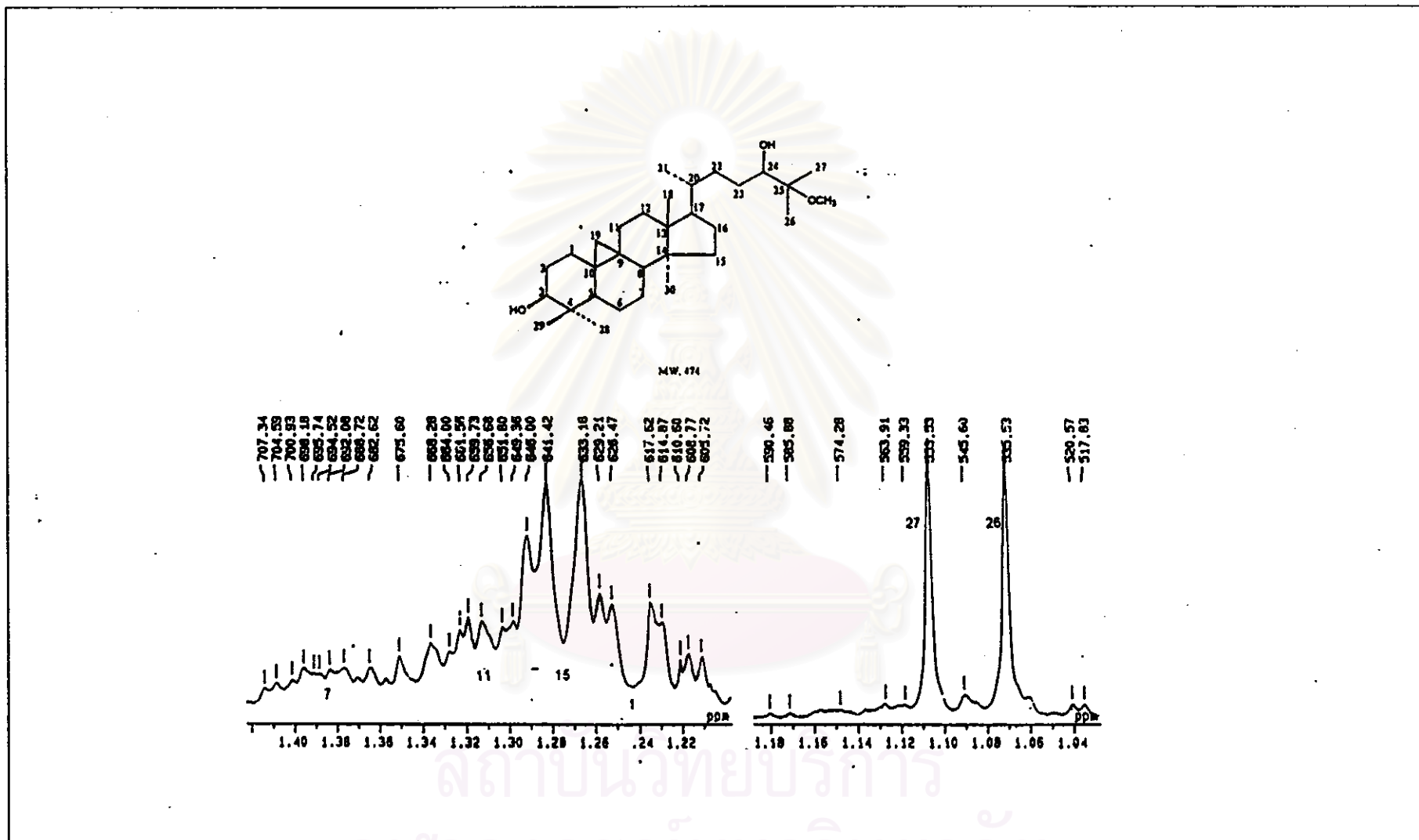


Figure 20 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 1.04-1.40 ppm)

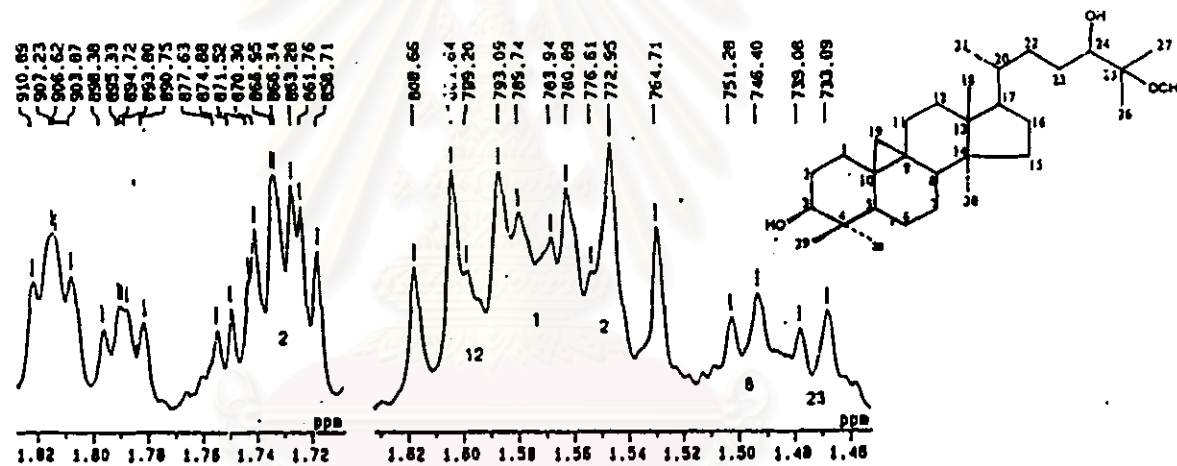


Figure 21 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 1.46-1.82 ppm)

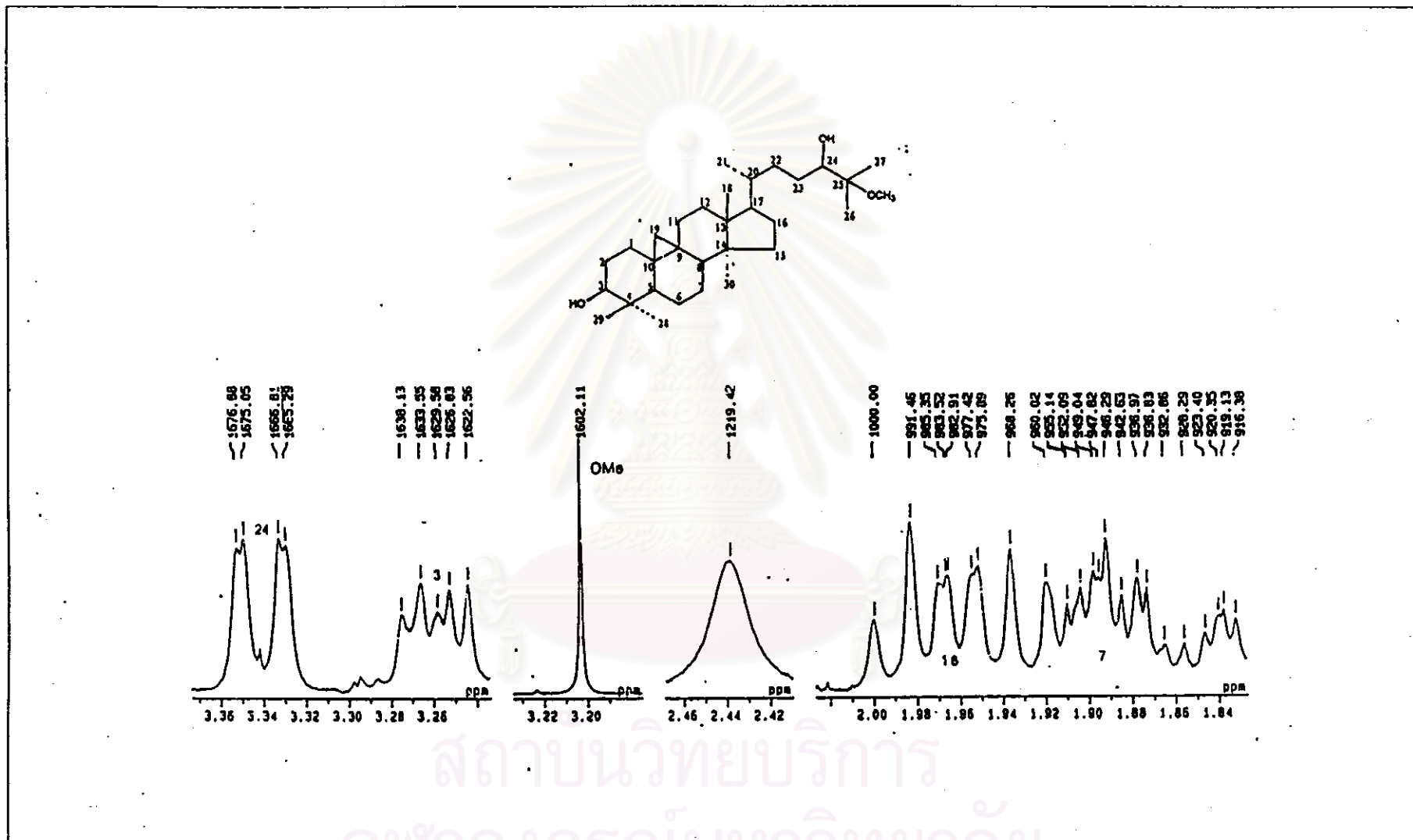


Figure 22 The 500 MHz ¹H NMR spectrum of compound ACH₂ (in CDCl₃) (expanded in the range of δ 1.84-3.36 ppm)

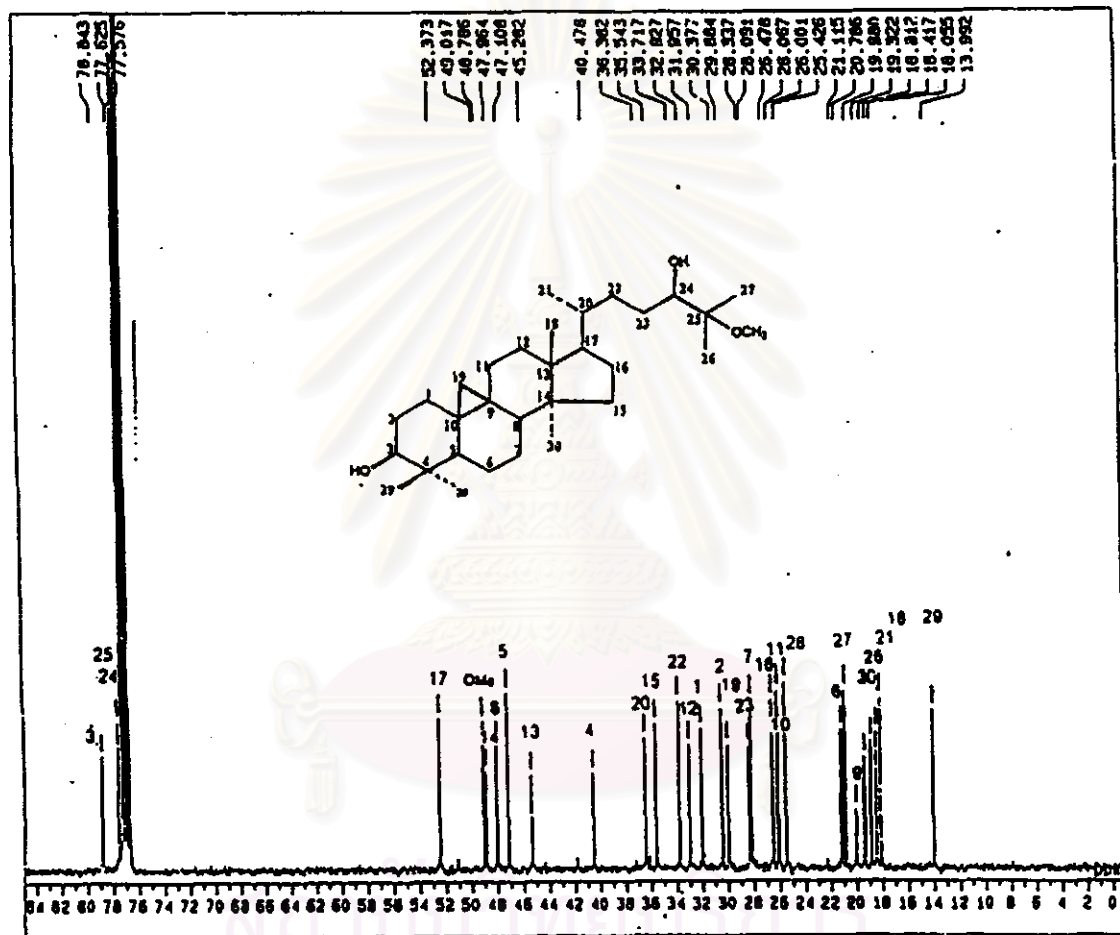


Figure 23 The 125 MHz ^{13}C NMR spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3)

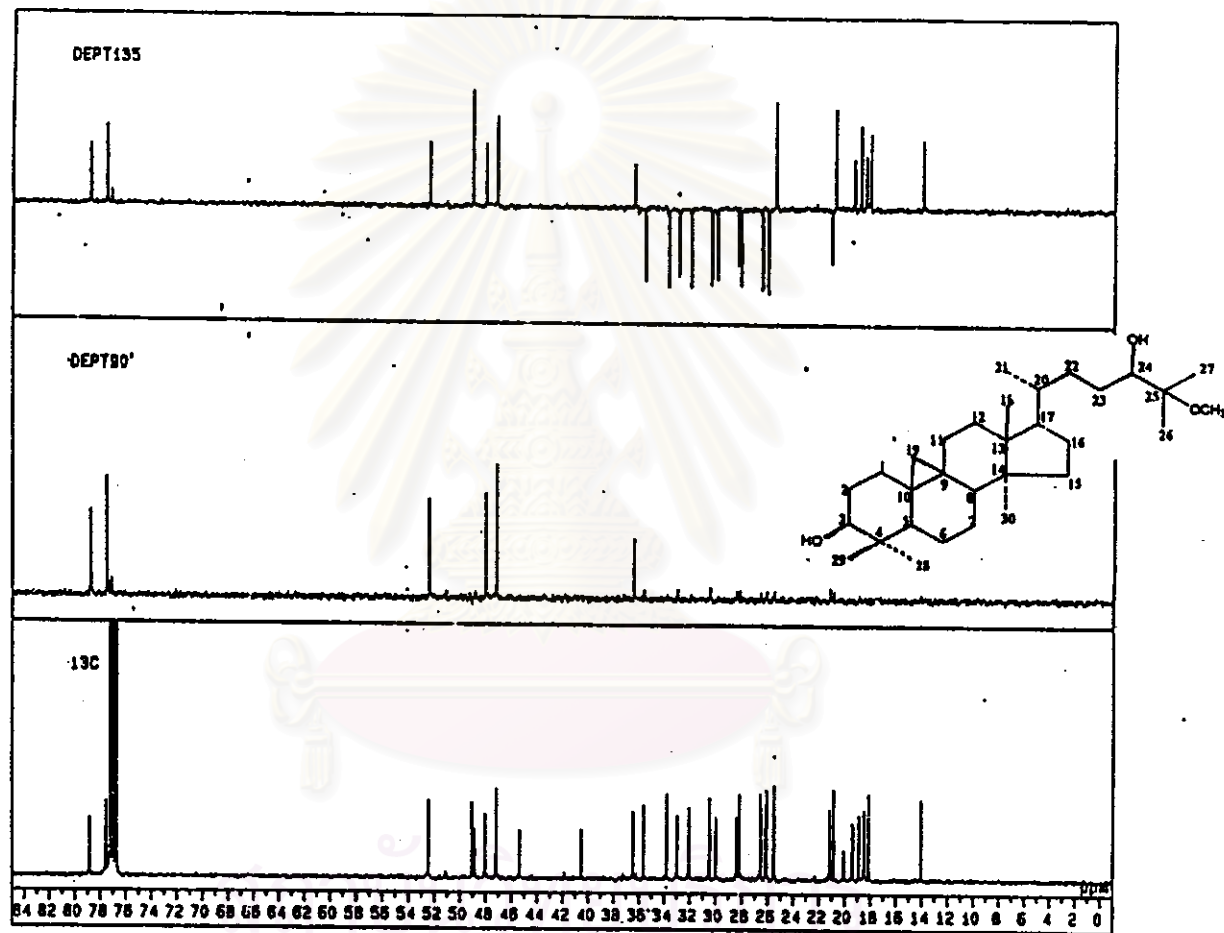


Figure 24 DEPT spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl₃)

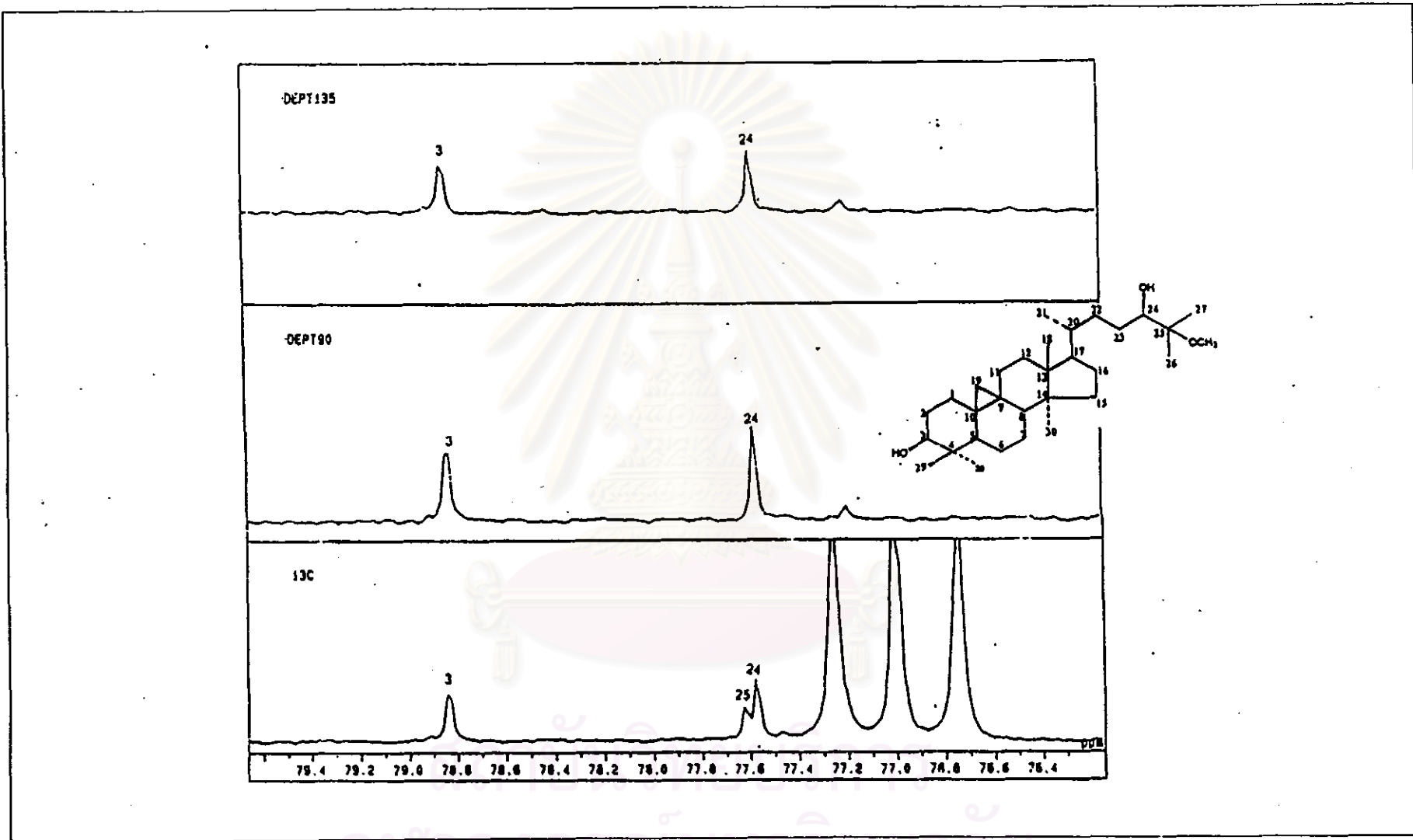


Figure 25 DEPT spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl₃) (expanded in the range of δ 76.4-79.4ppm)

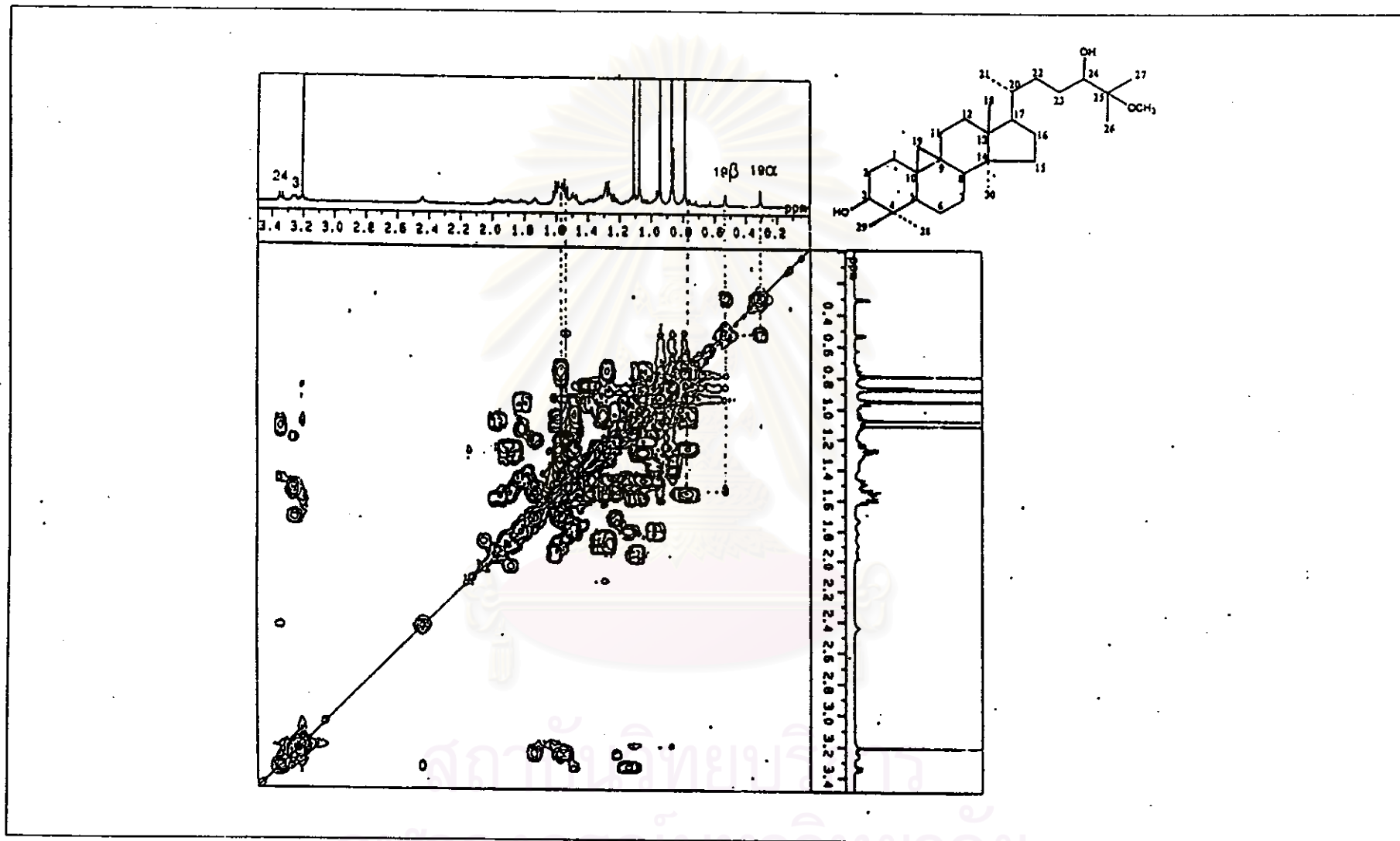


Figure 26 ^1H - ^1H COSY spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-3.4ppm and $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-3.4ppm)

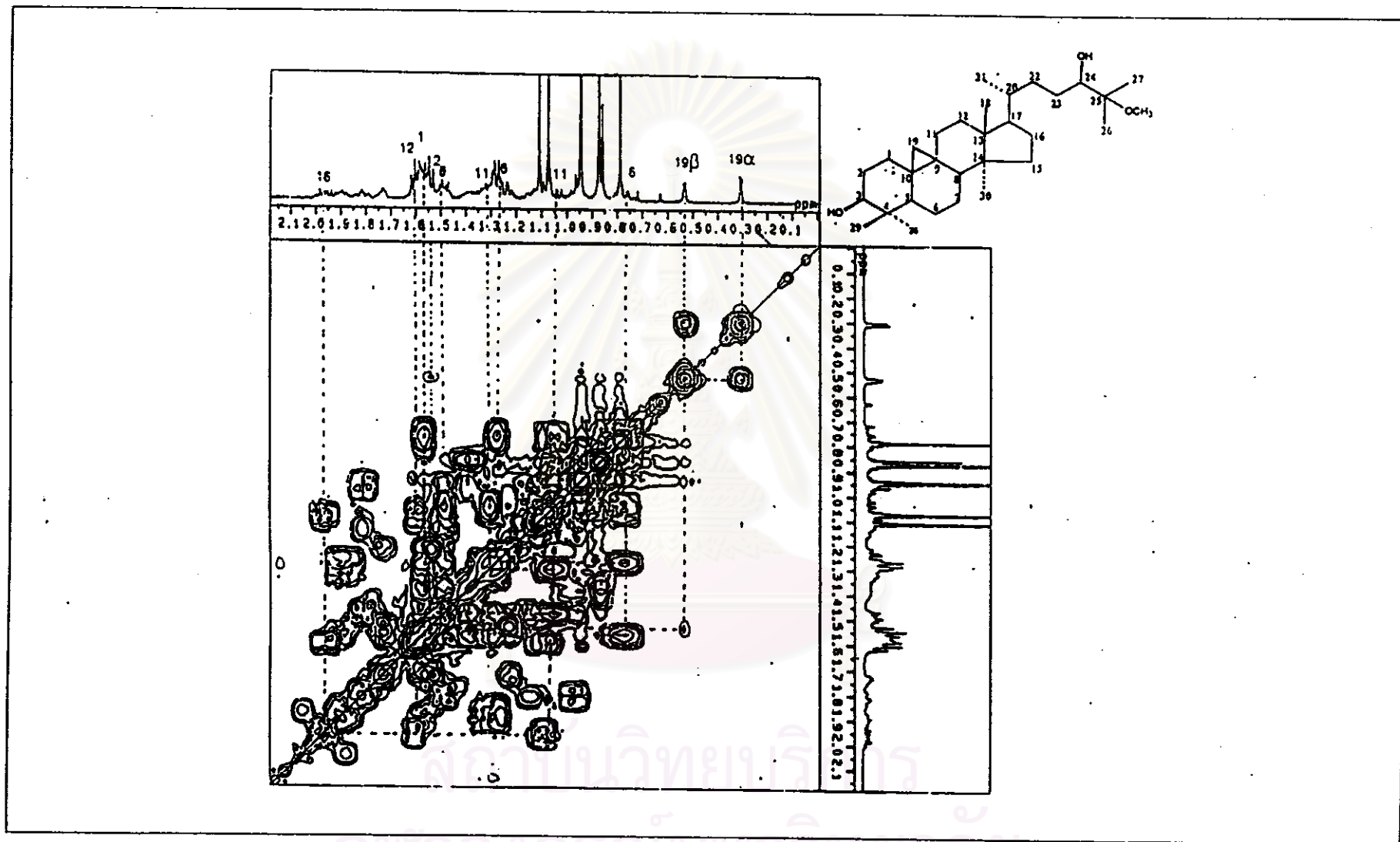


Figure 27 ^1H - ^1H COSY spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.2ppm and $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.2ppm)

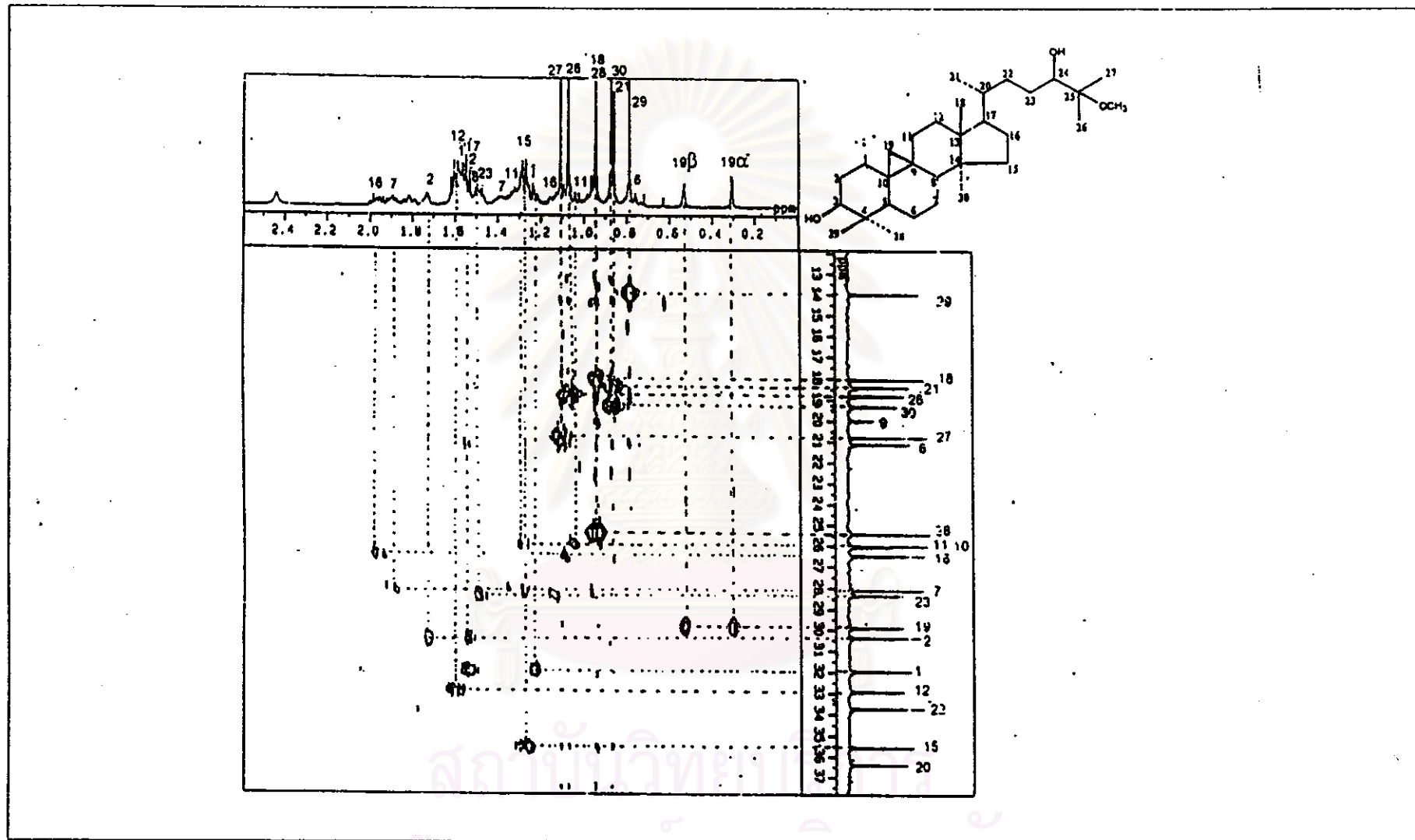


Figure 28 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 0-2.4 ppm and δ ^{13}C 12-38 ppm)

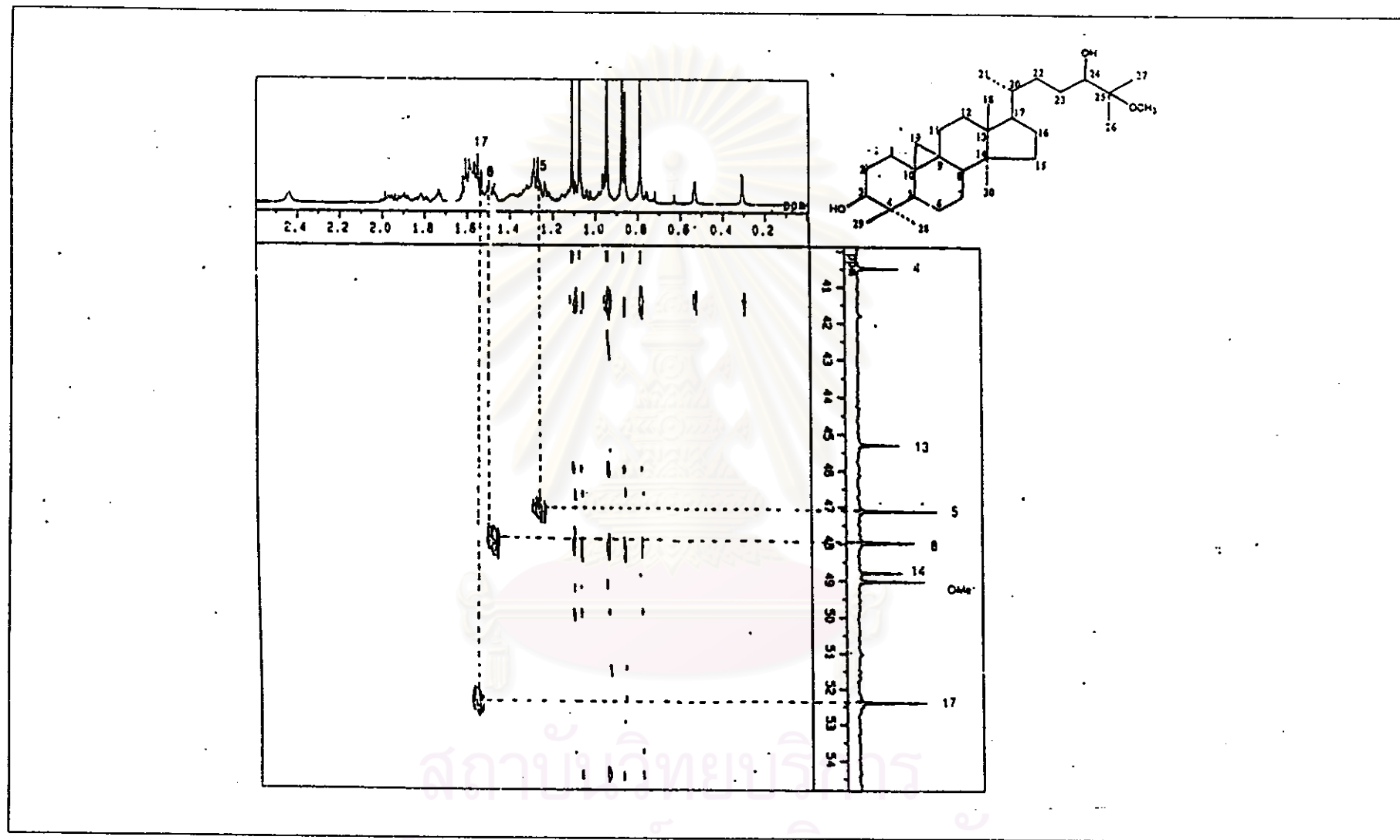


Figure 29 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.4 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 40-55 ppm)

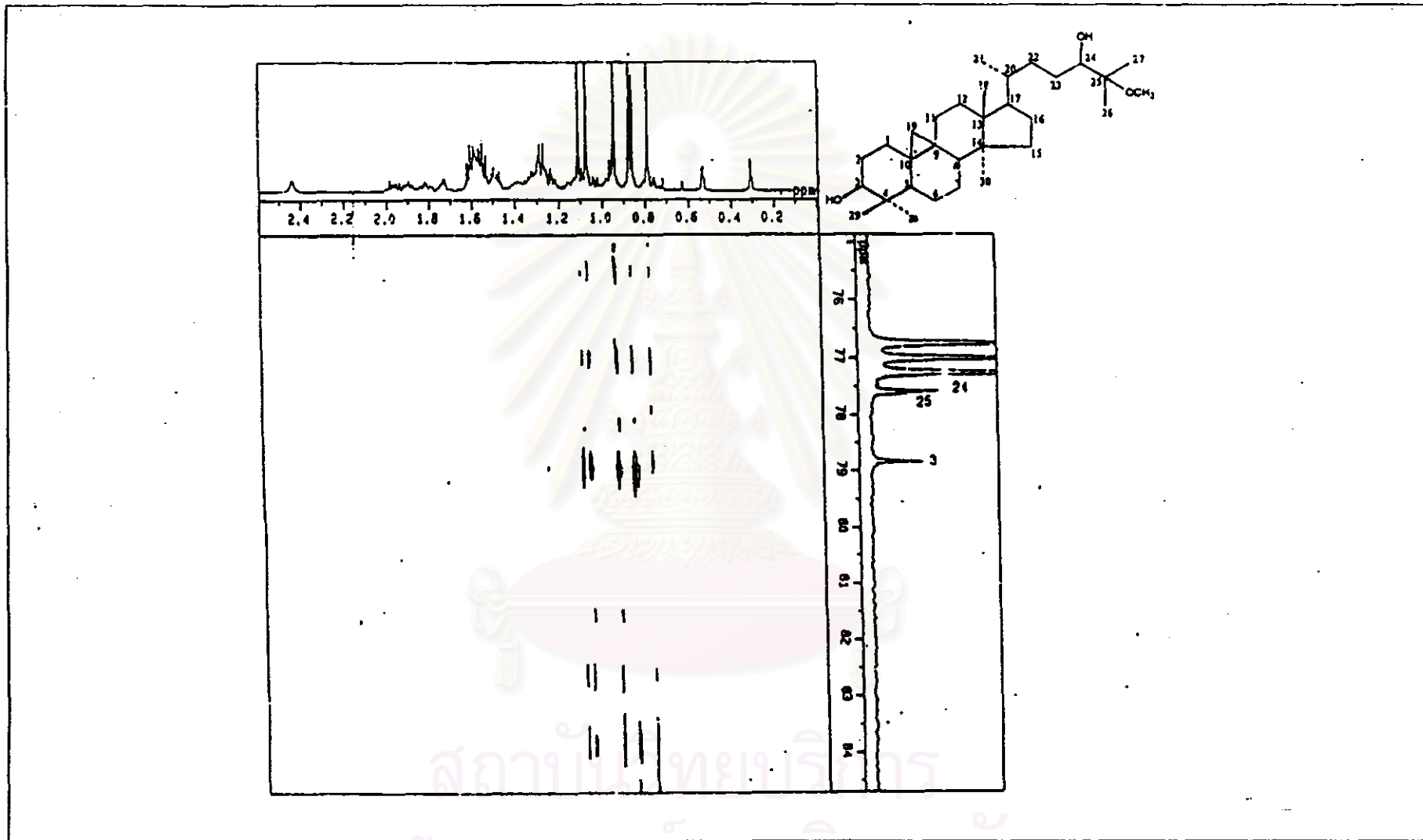


Figure 30 $^1\text{H}-^{13}\text{C}$ HMQC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.4 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 75-84 ppm)

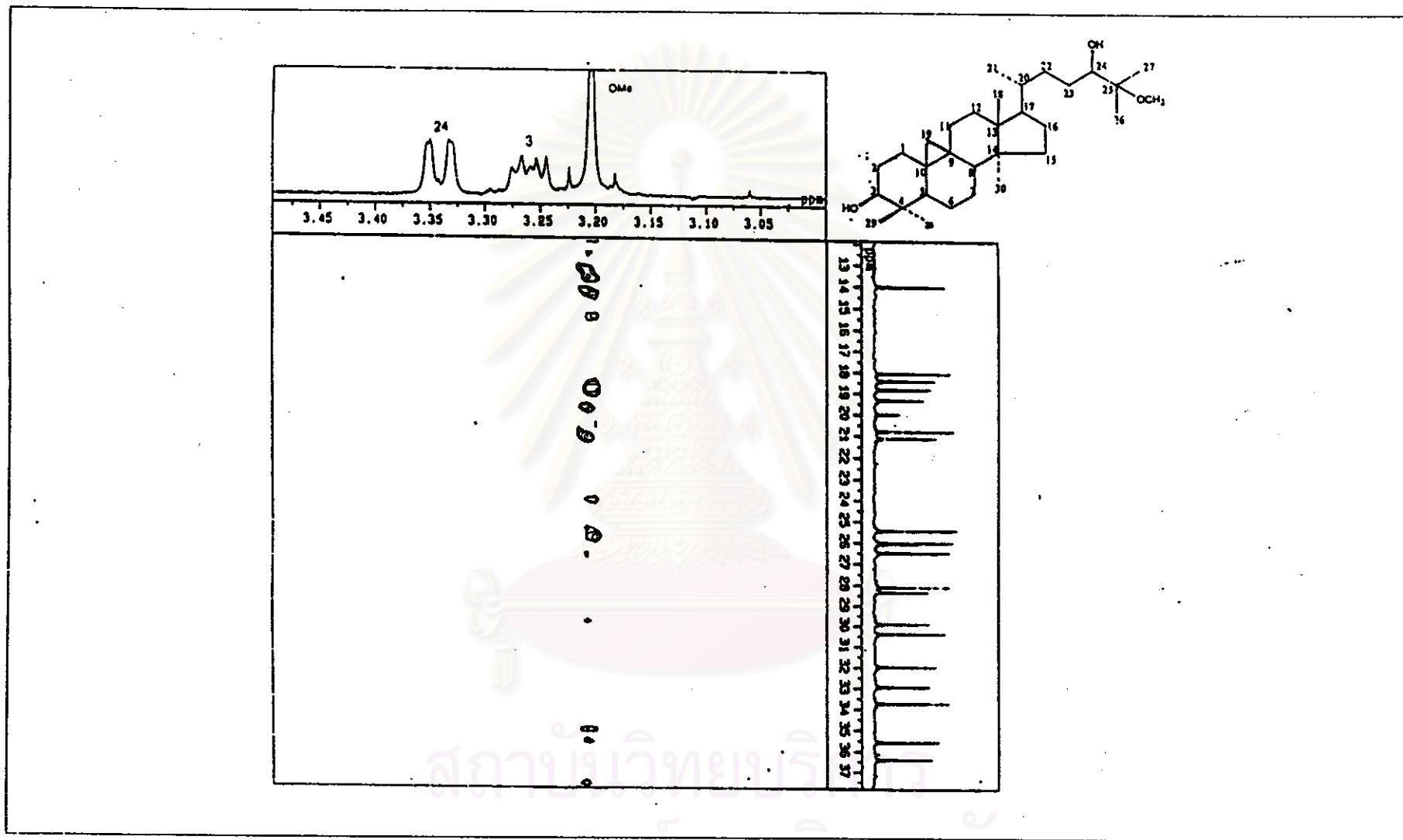


Figure 31 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 3.05-3.45 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 12-38 ppm)

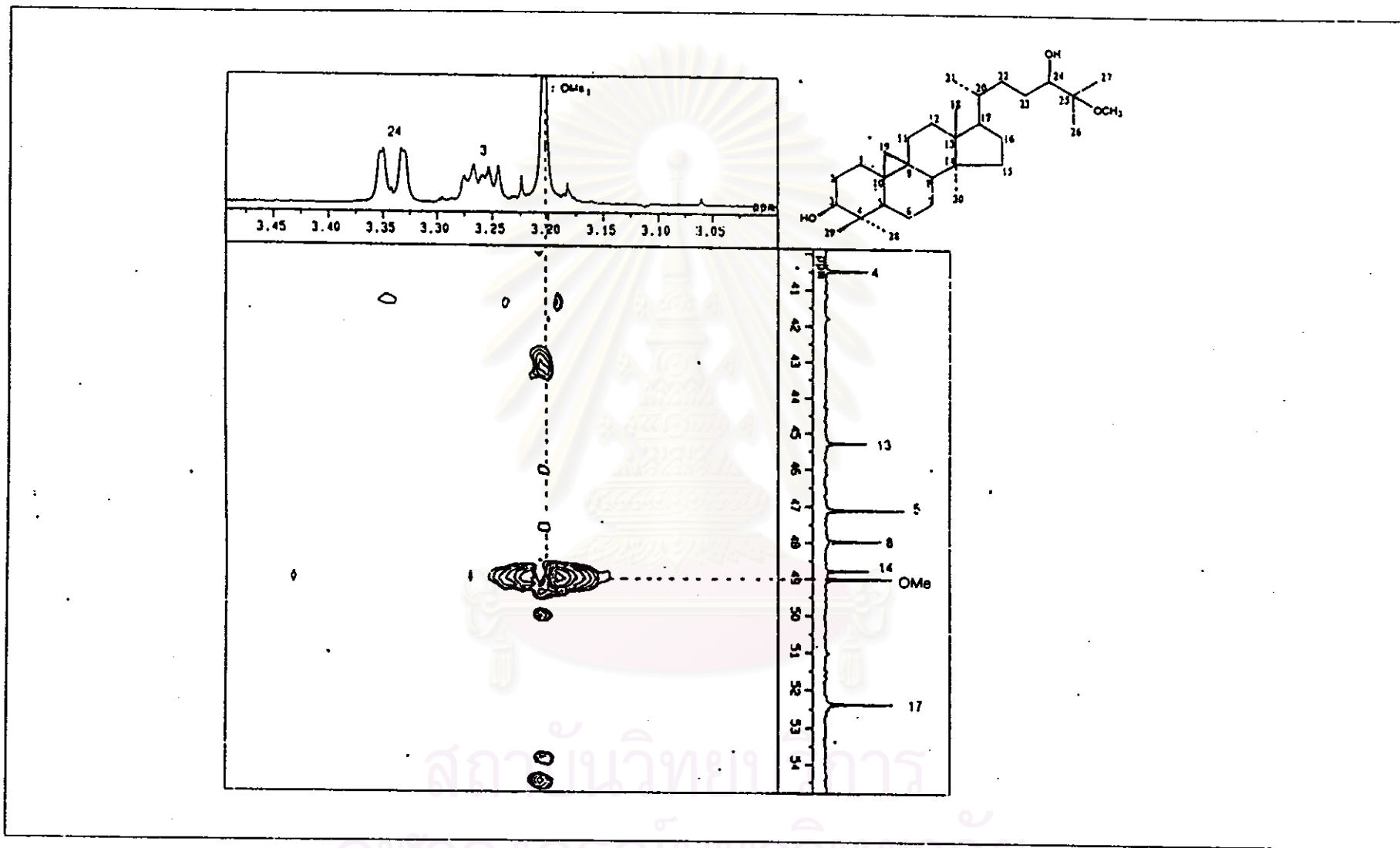


Figure 32 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 3.05-3.45 ppm and δ ^{13}C 40-55 ppm)

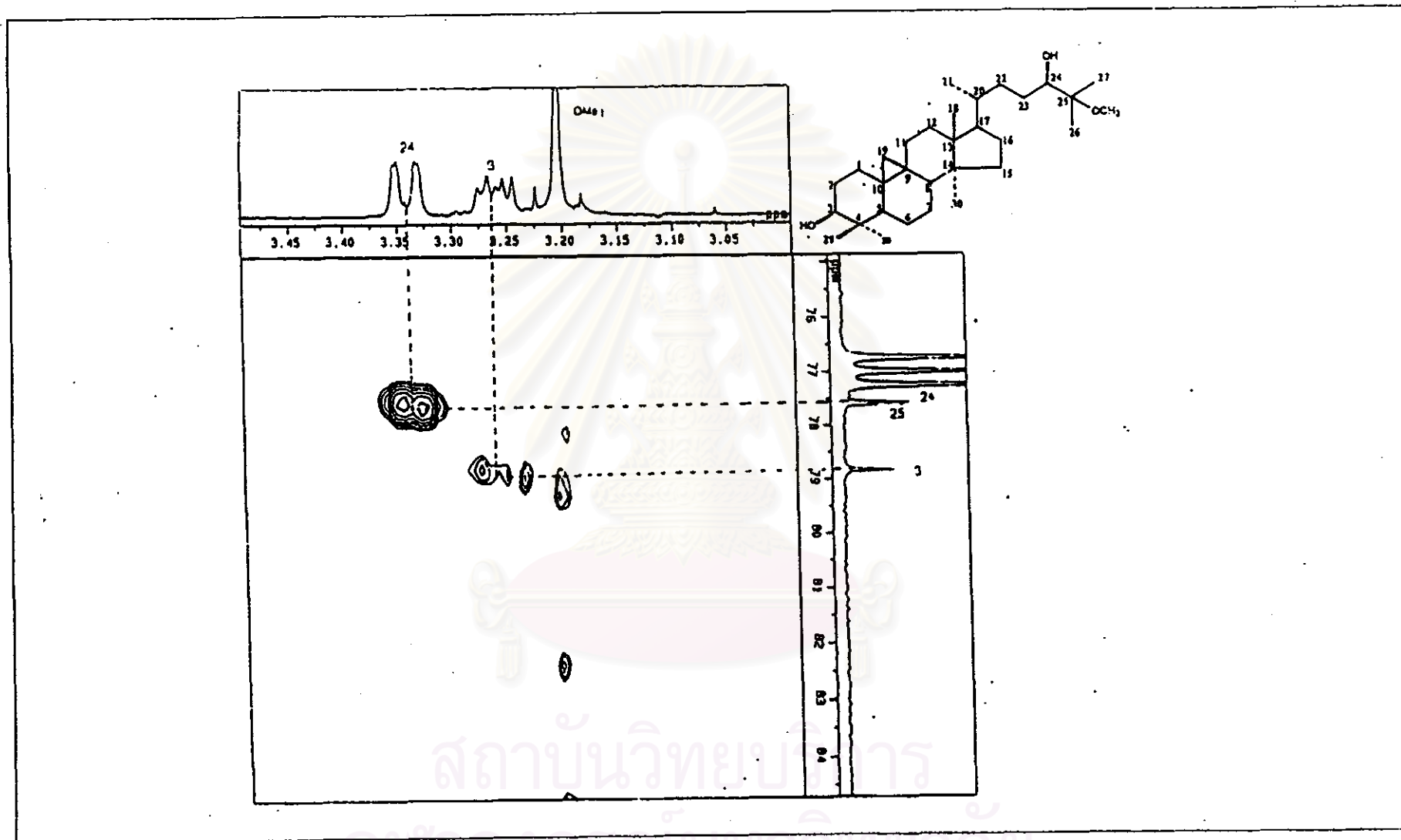


Figure 33 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 3.05-3.45 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 75-85 ppm)

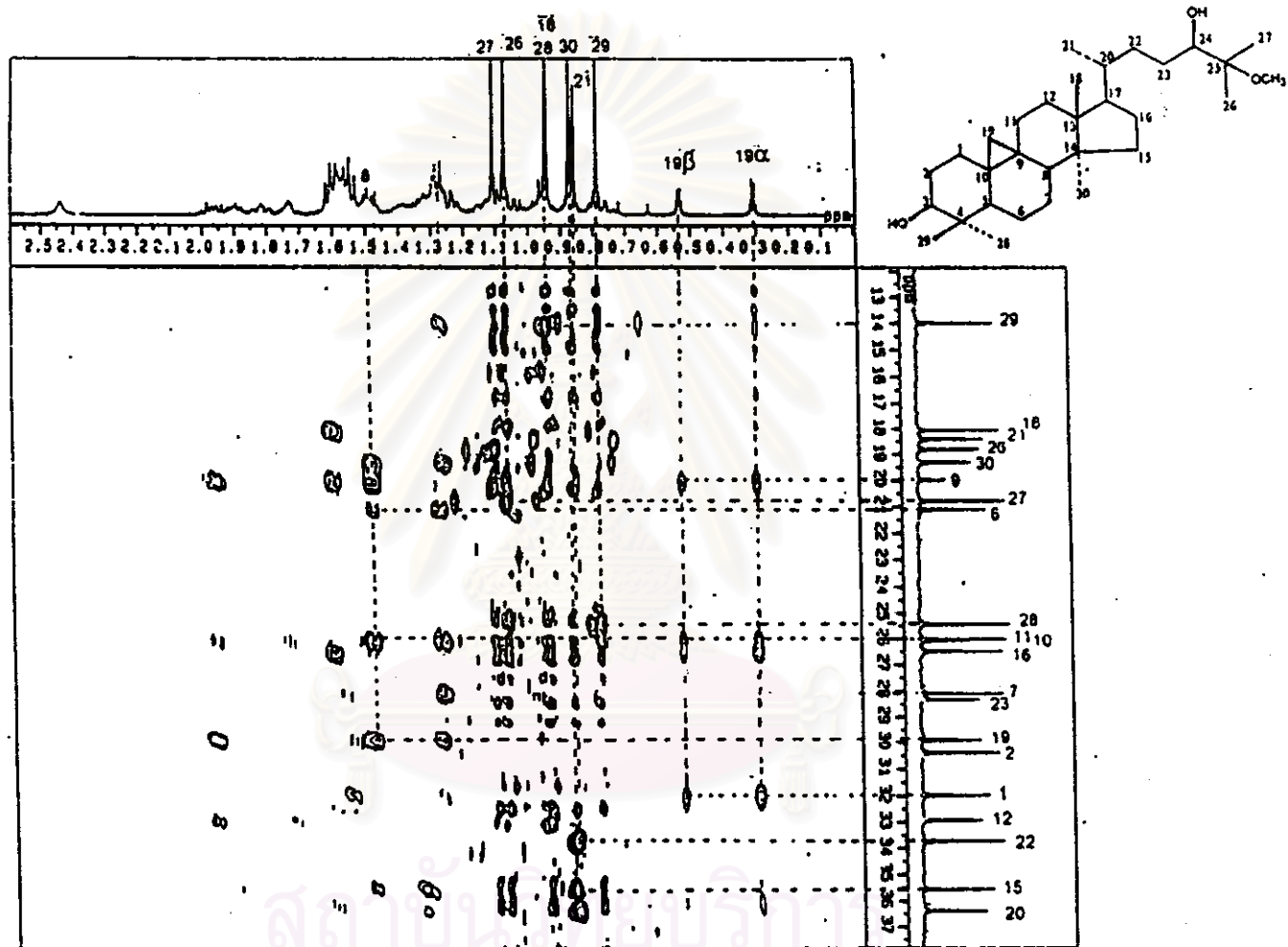


Figure 34 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 0-2.6 ppm and δ ^{13}C 12-38 ppm)

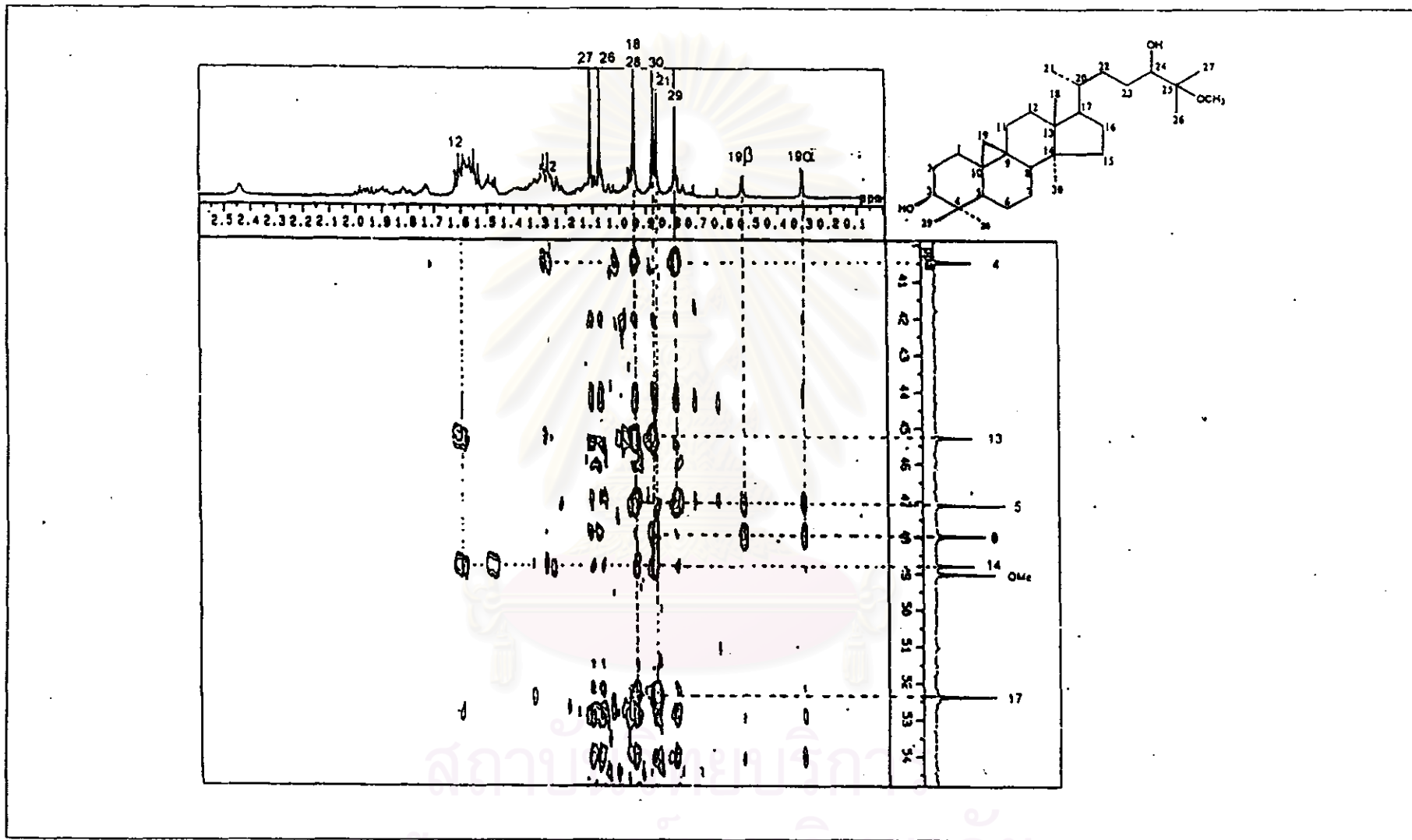


Figure 35 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.6 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 40-55 ppm)

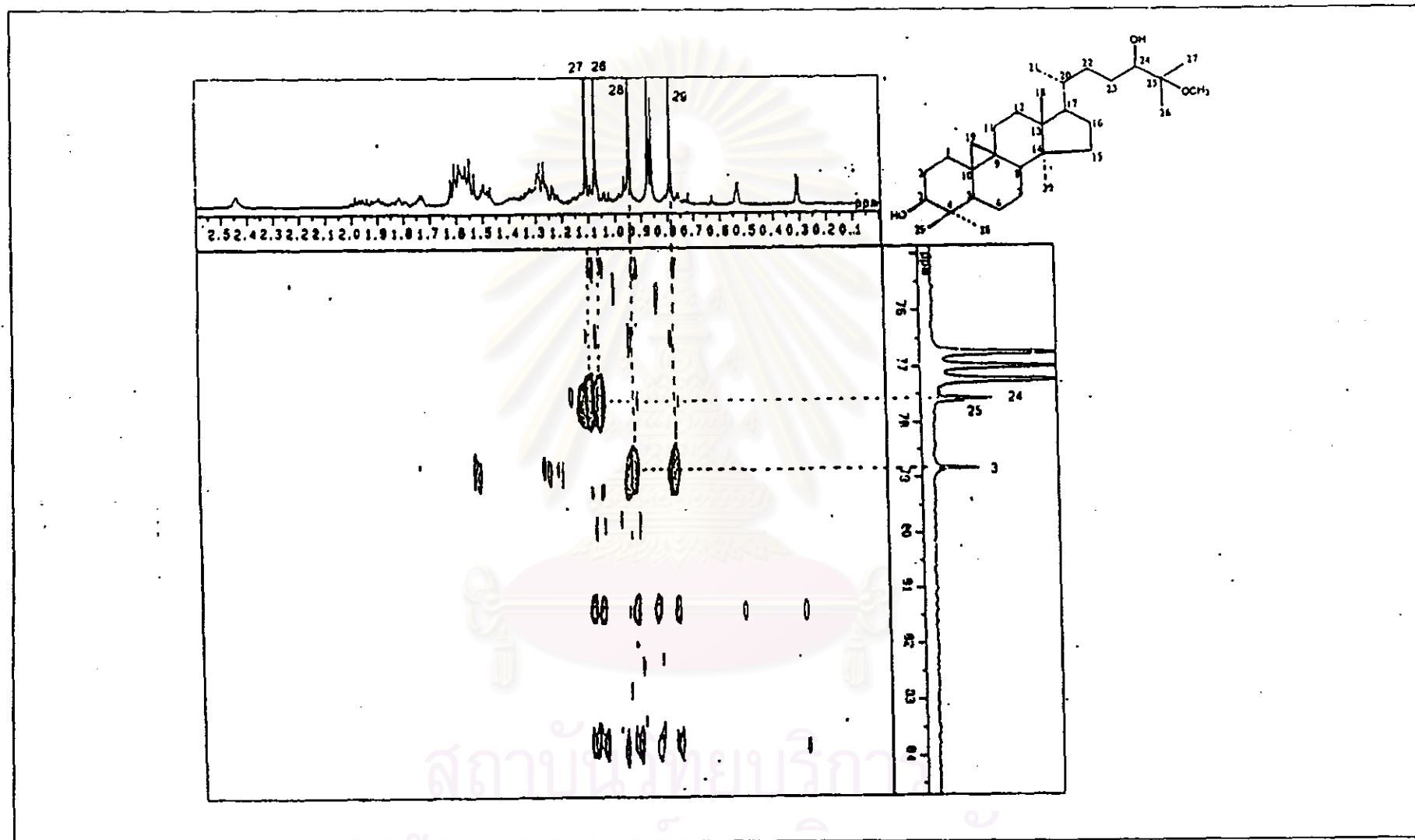


Figure 36 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.5 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 70-85 ppm)

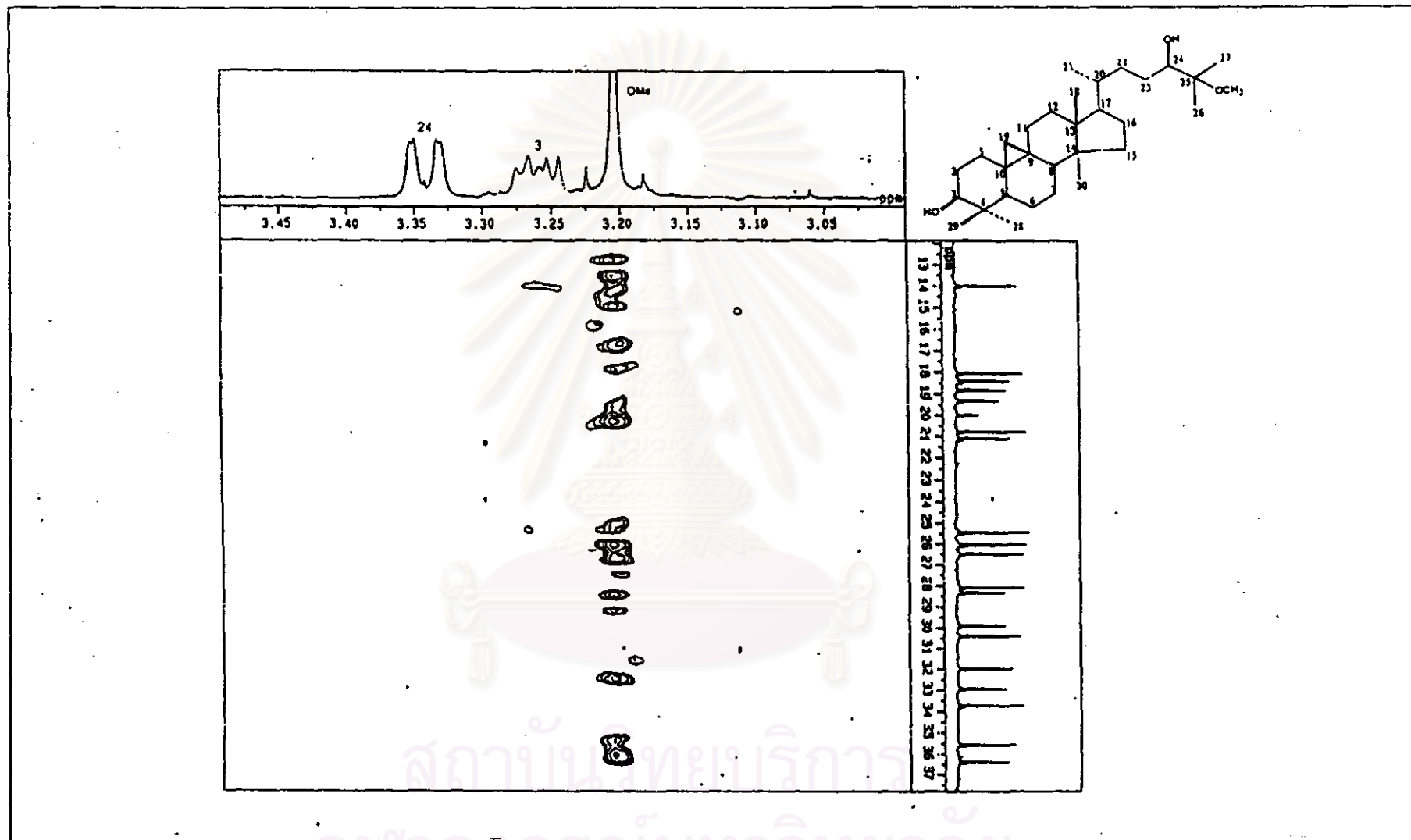


Figure 37 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 3.05-3.45 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 12-37 ppm)

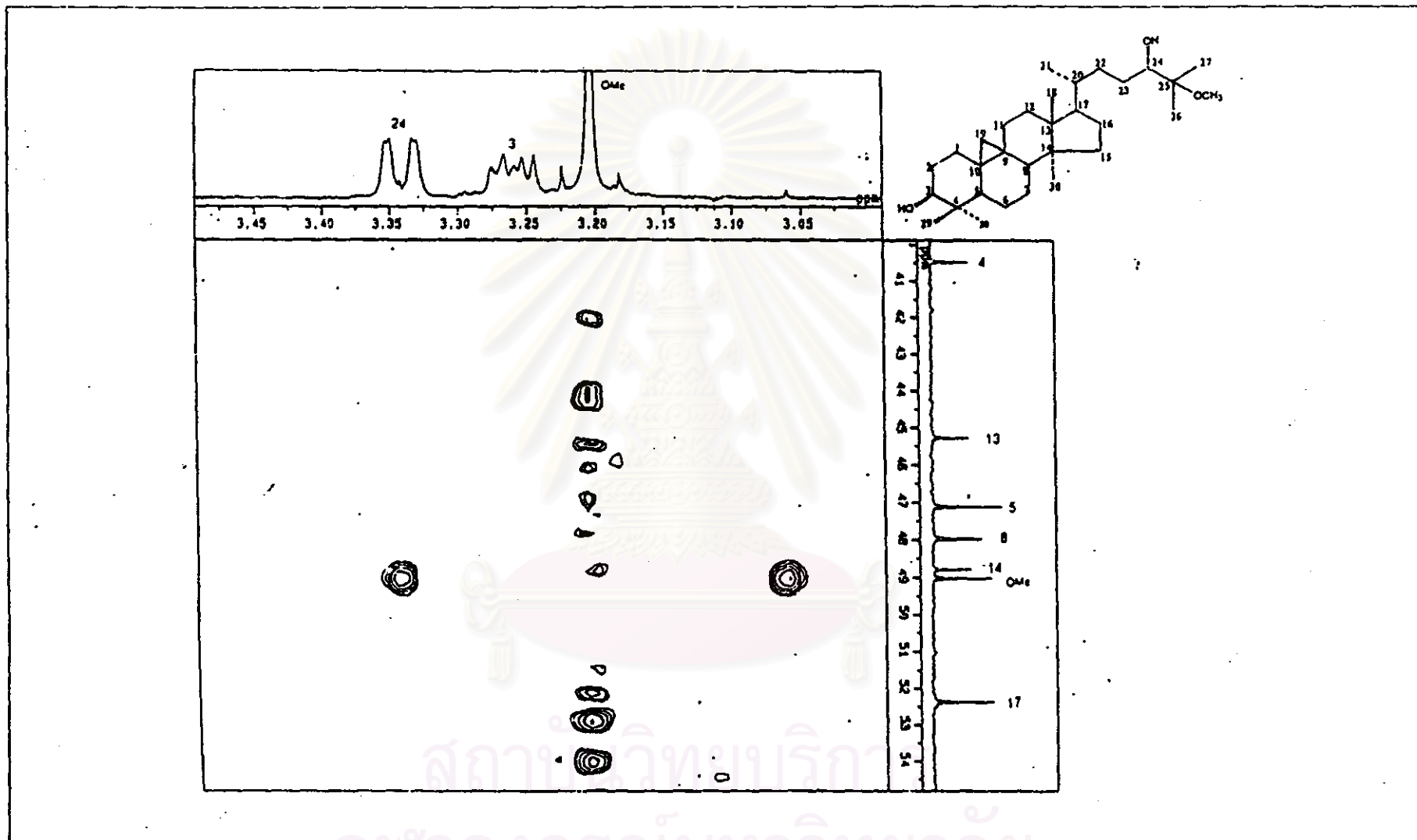


Figure 38 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 3.05-3.45 ppm and δ ^{13}C 40-55 ppm)

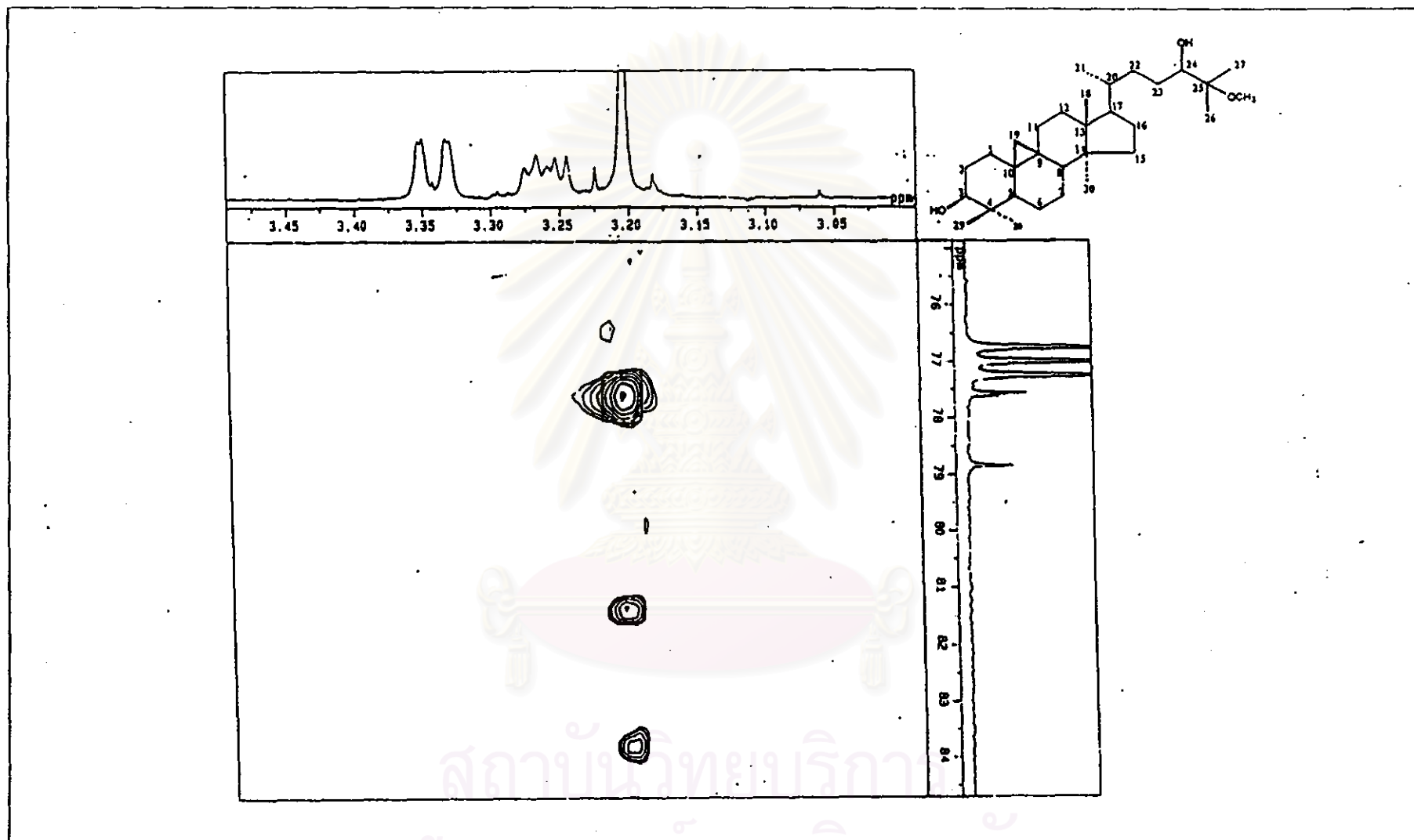


Figure 39 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH2 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 3.05-3.45 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 75-85 ppm)

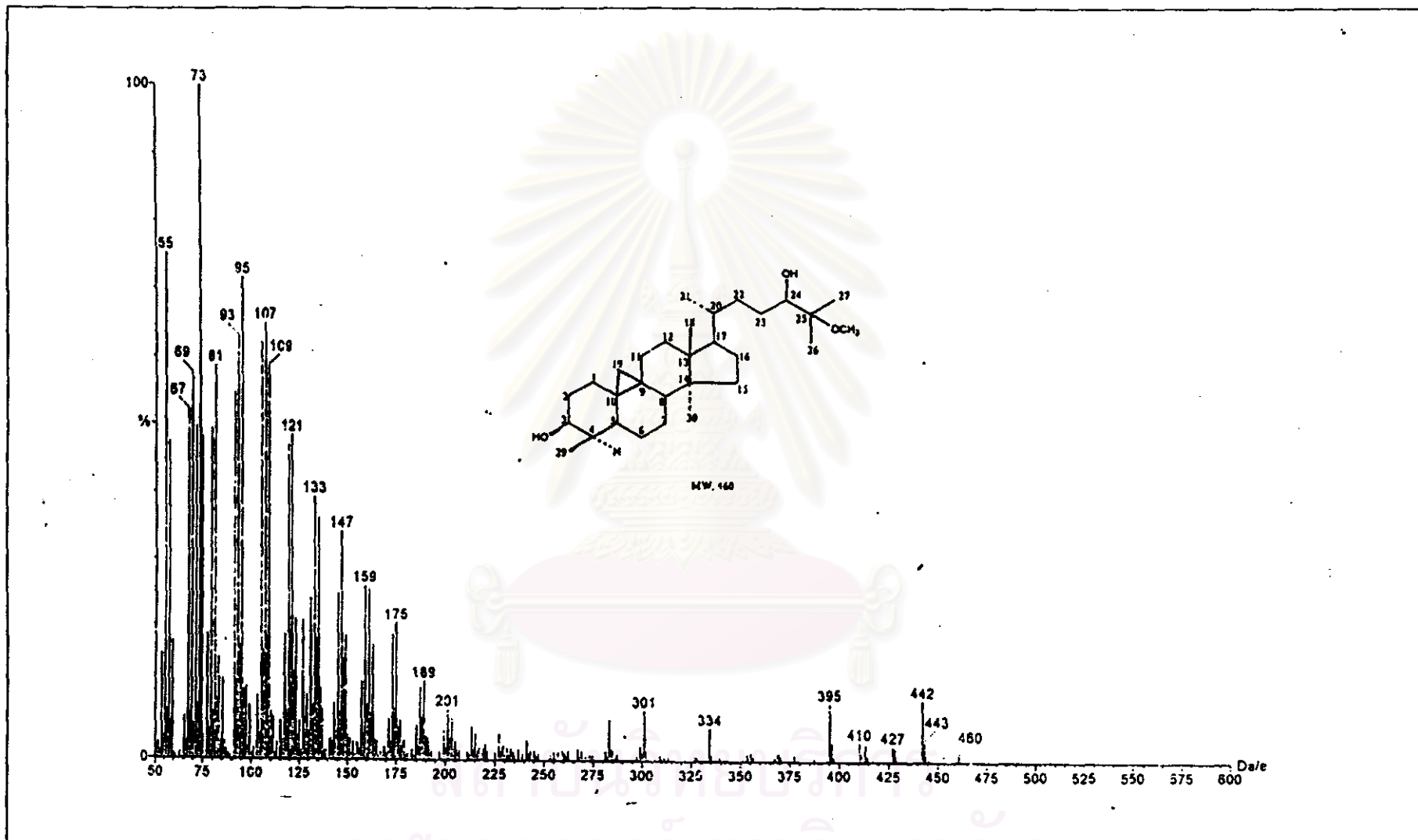


Figure 40 EIMS spectrum of compound ACH3

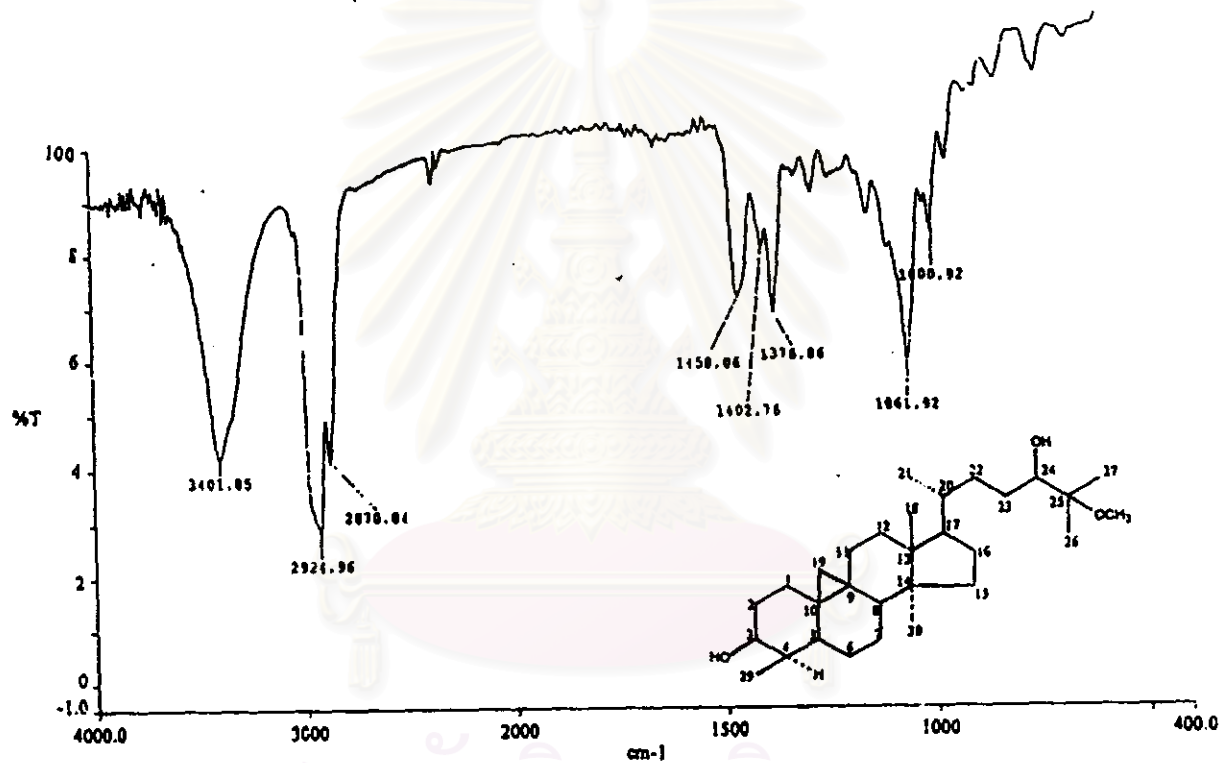


Figure 41 IR spectrum of compound ACH3 (KBr disc)

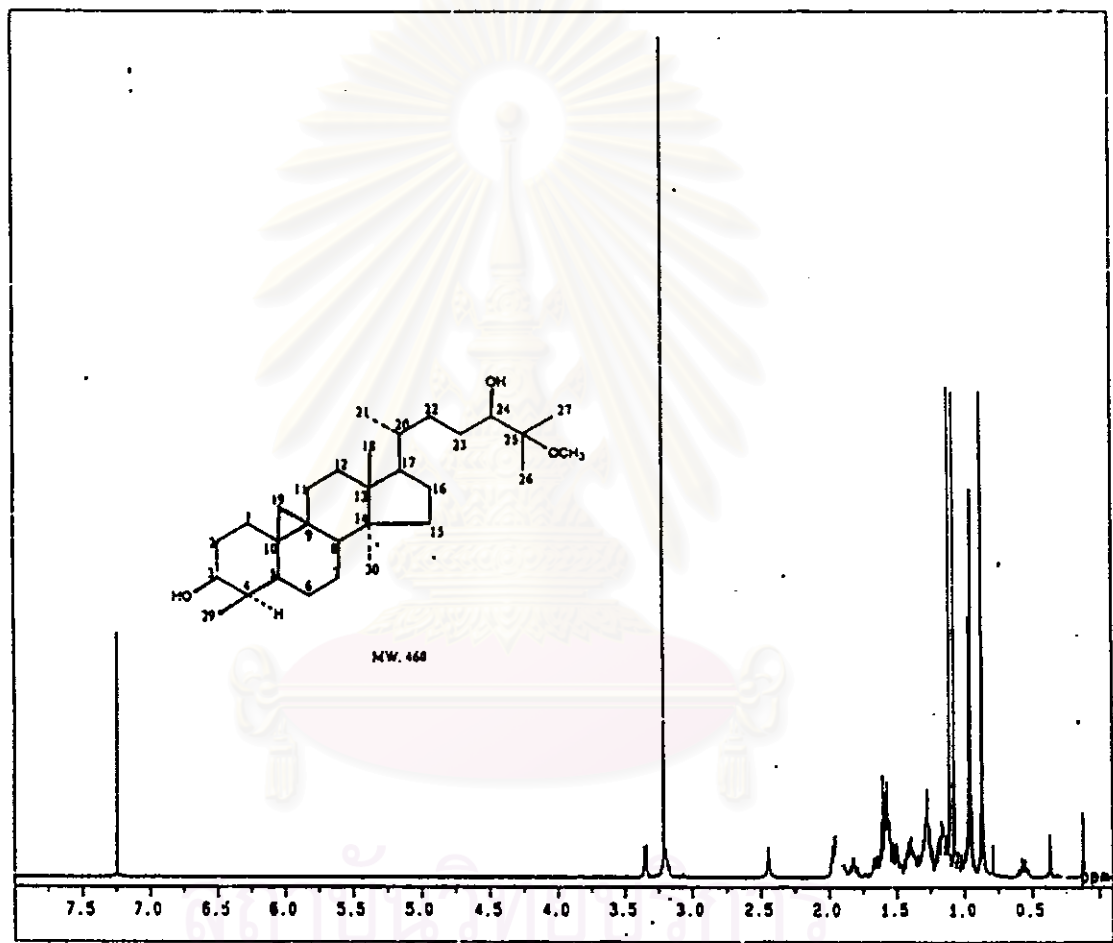


Figure 42 The 500 MHz ¹H NMR spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl₃)

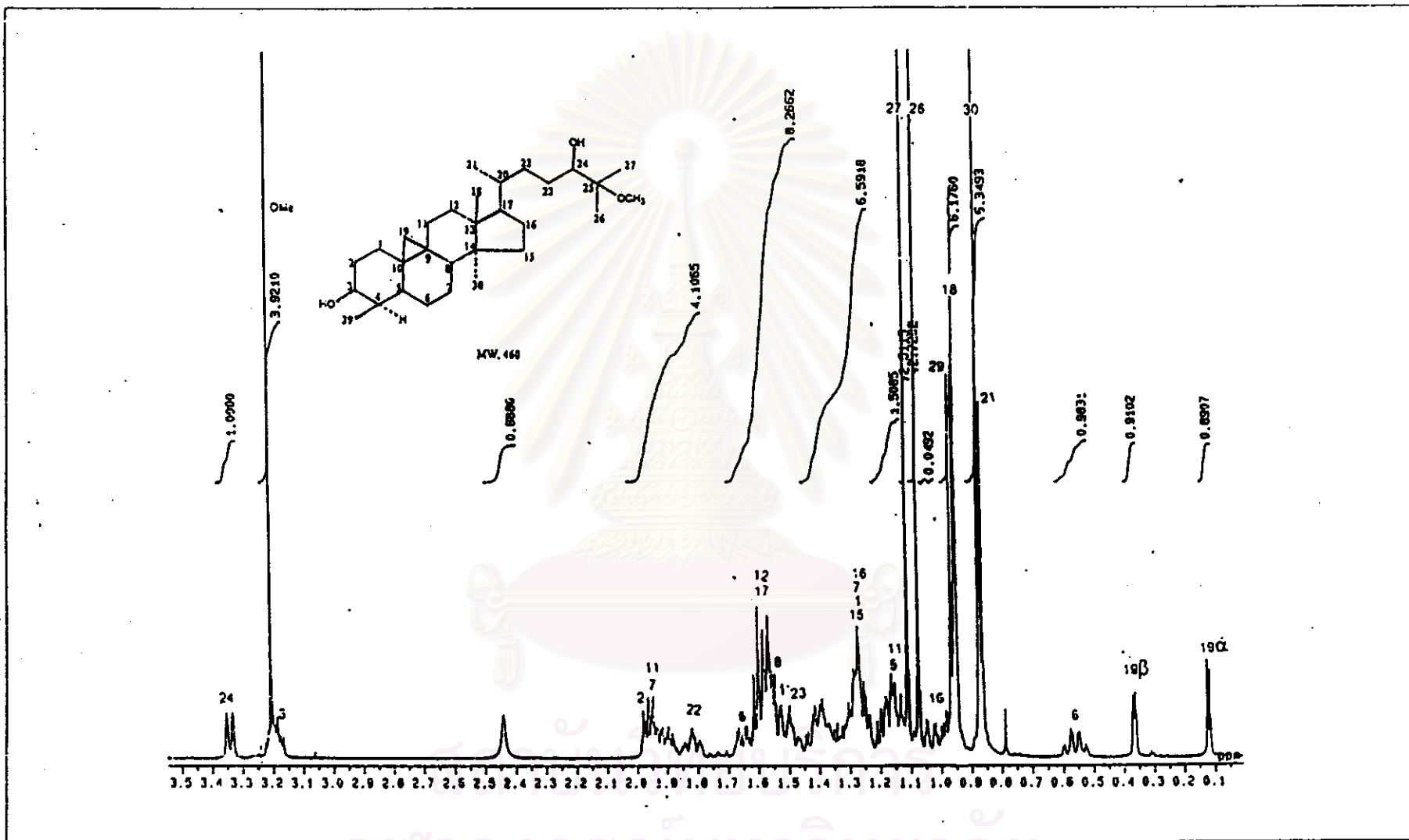


Figure 43 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH₃ (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 0-3.5 ppm)

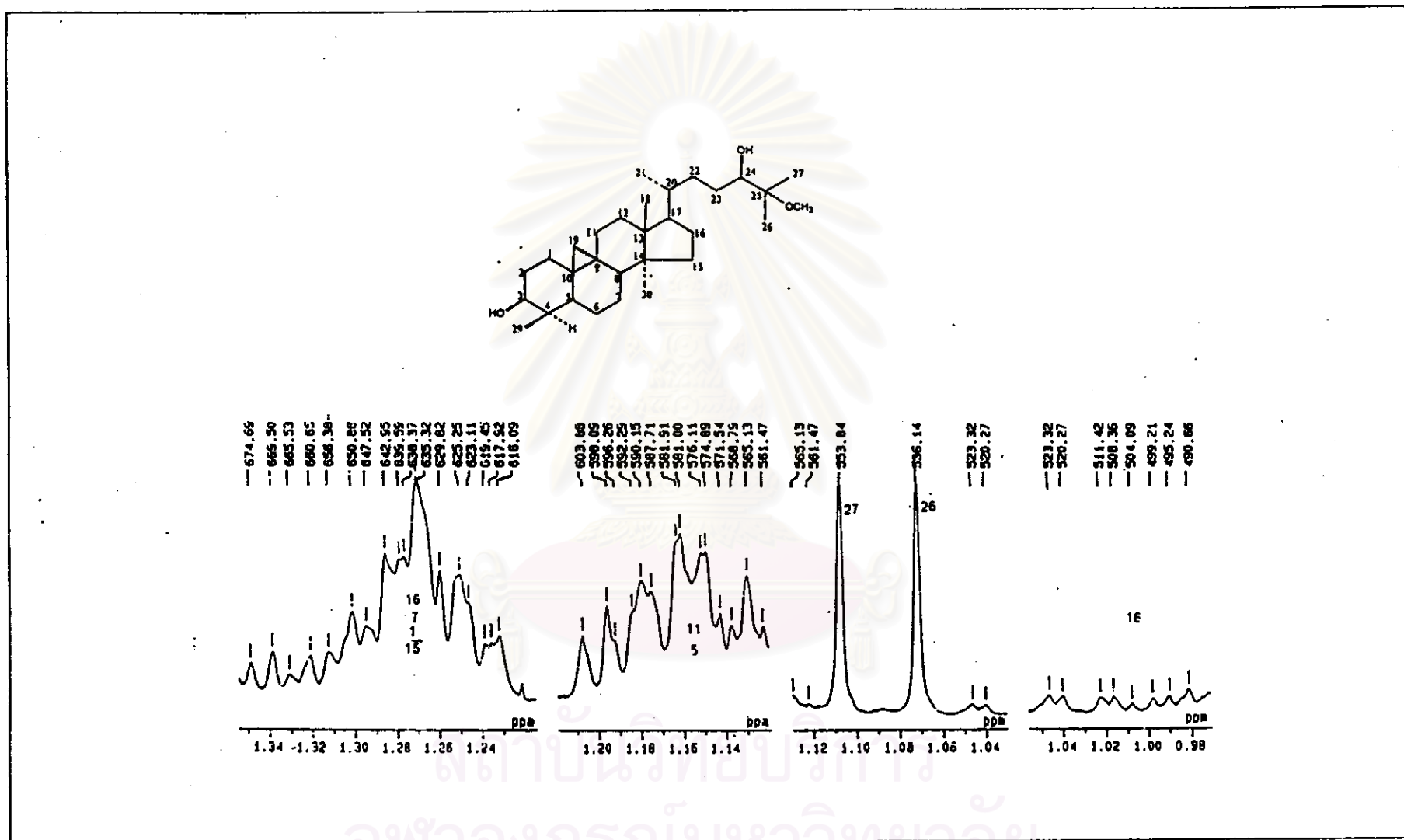


Figure 45 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 0.98-1.35ppm)

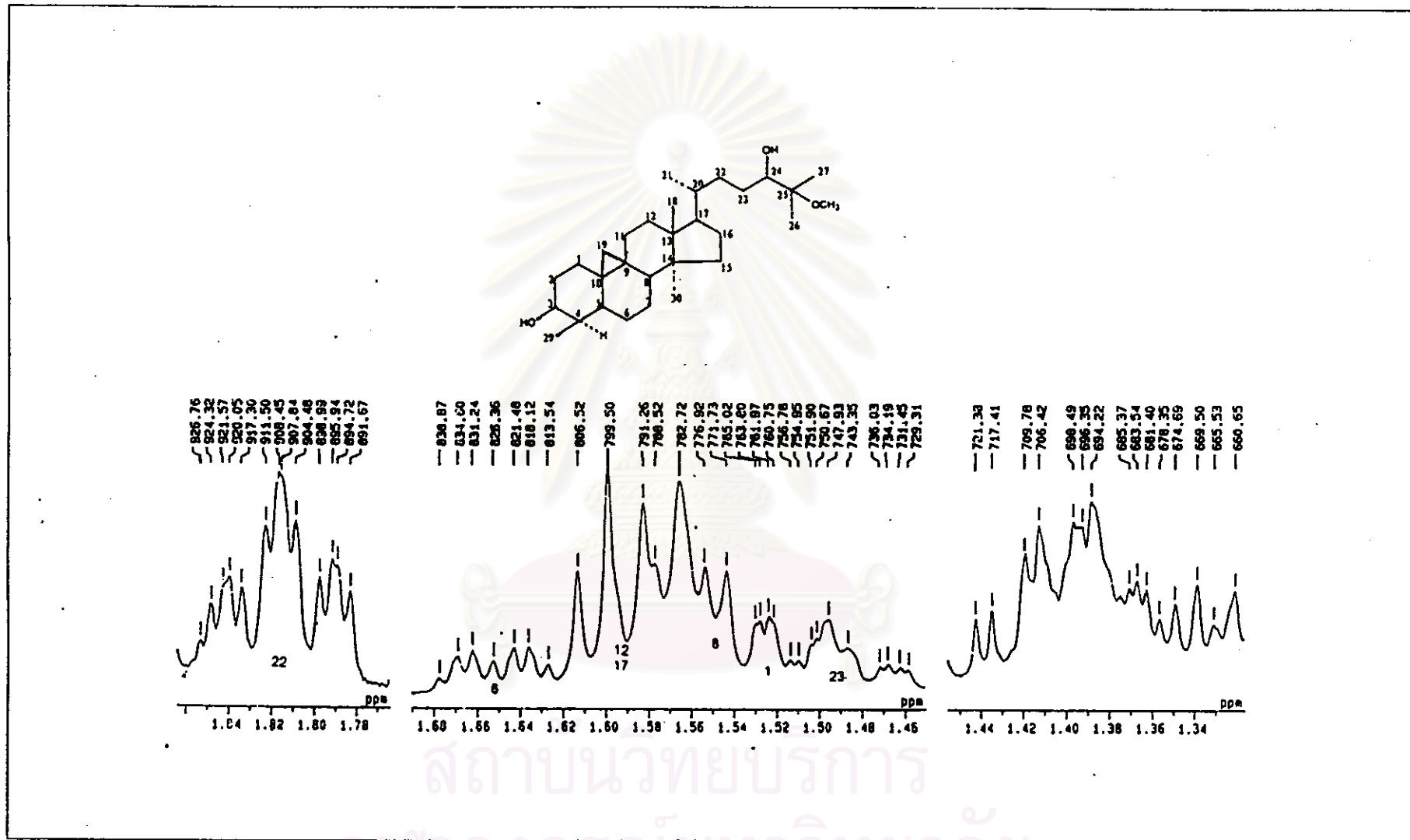


Figure 46 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 1.34-1.85ppm)

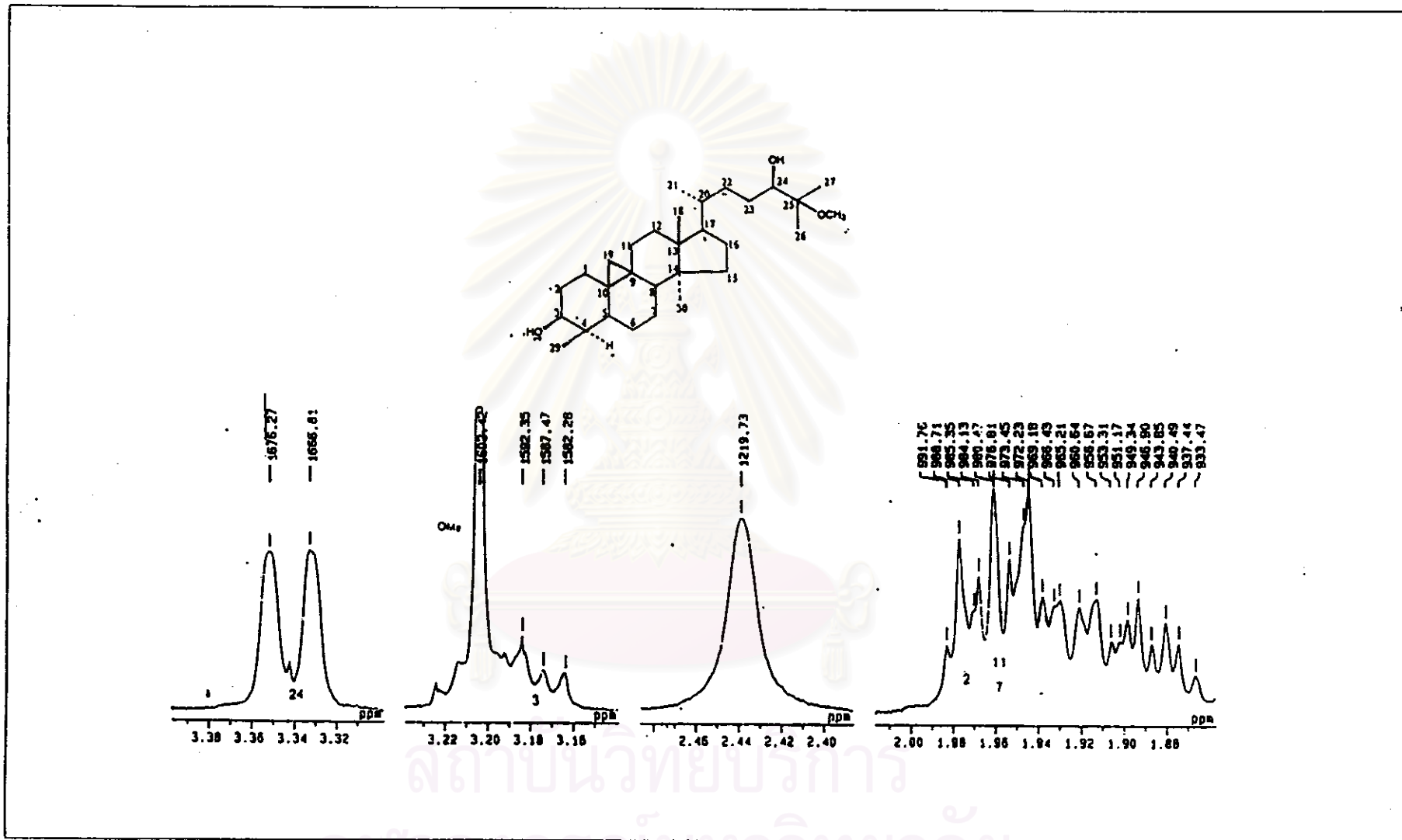


Figure 47 The 500 MHz ^1H NMR spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ 1.88-3.38ppm)

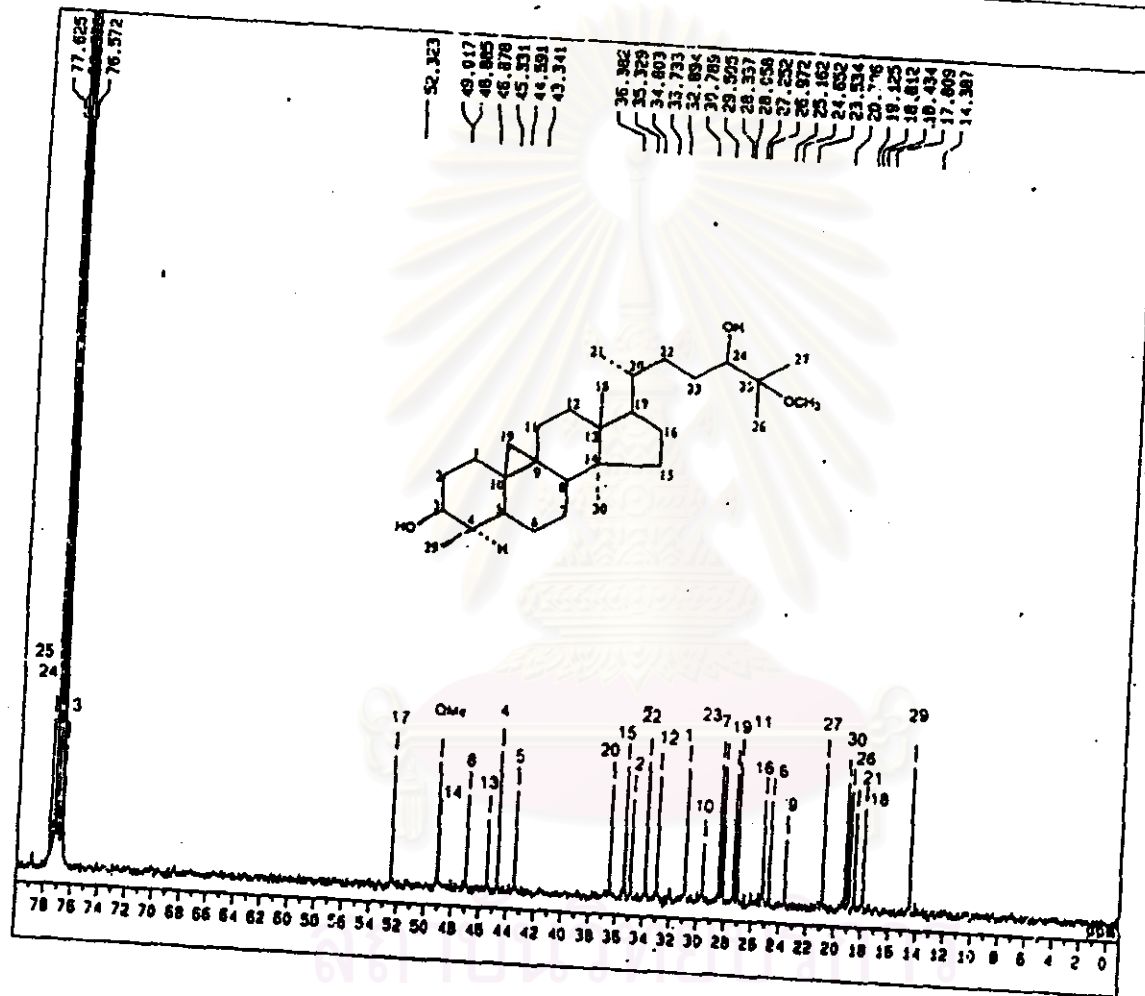


Figure 48 The 125 MHz ^{13}C NMR spectrum of compound ACH3(in CDCl_3)

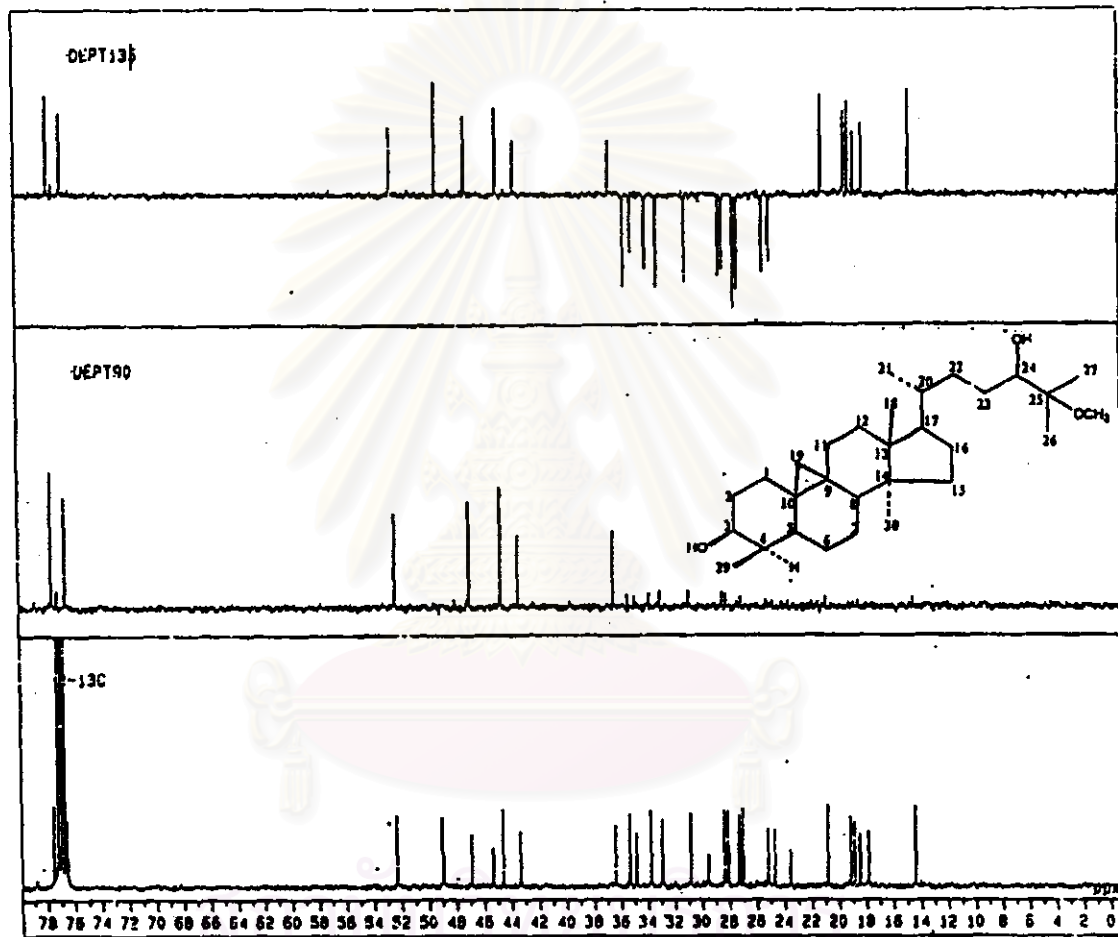


Figure 49 DEPT spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl₃)

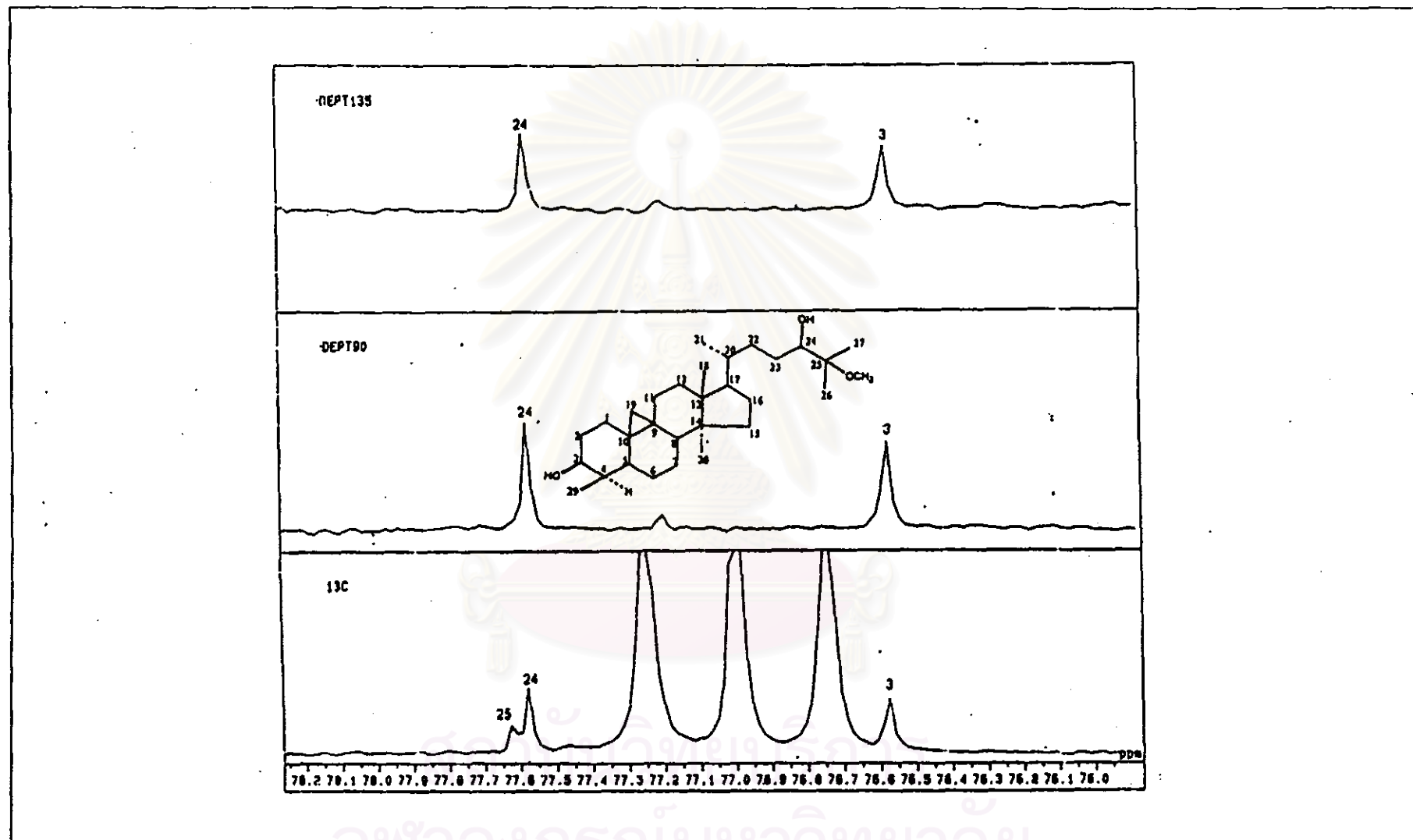


Figure 50 DEPT spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl₃) (expanded in the range of δ 76.0-78.2ppm)

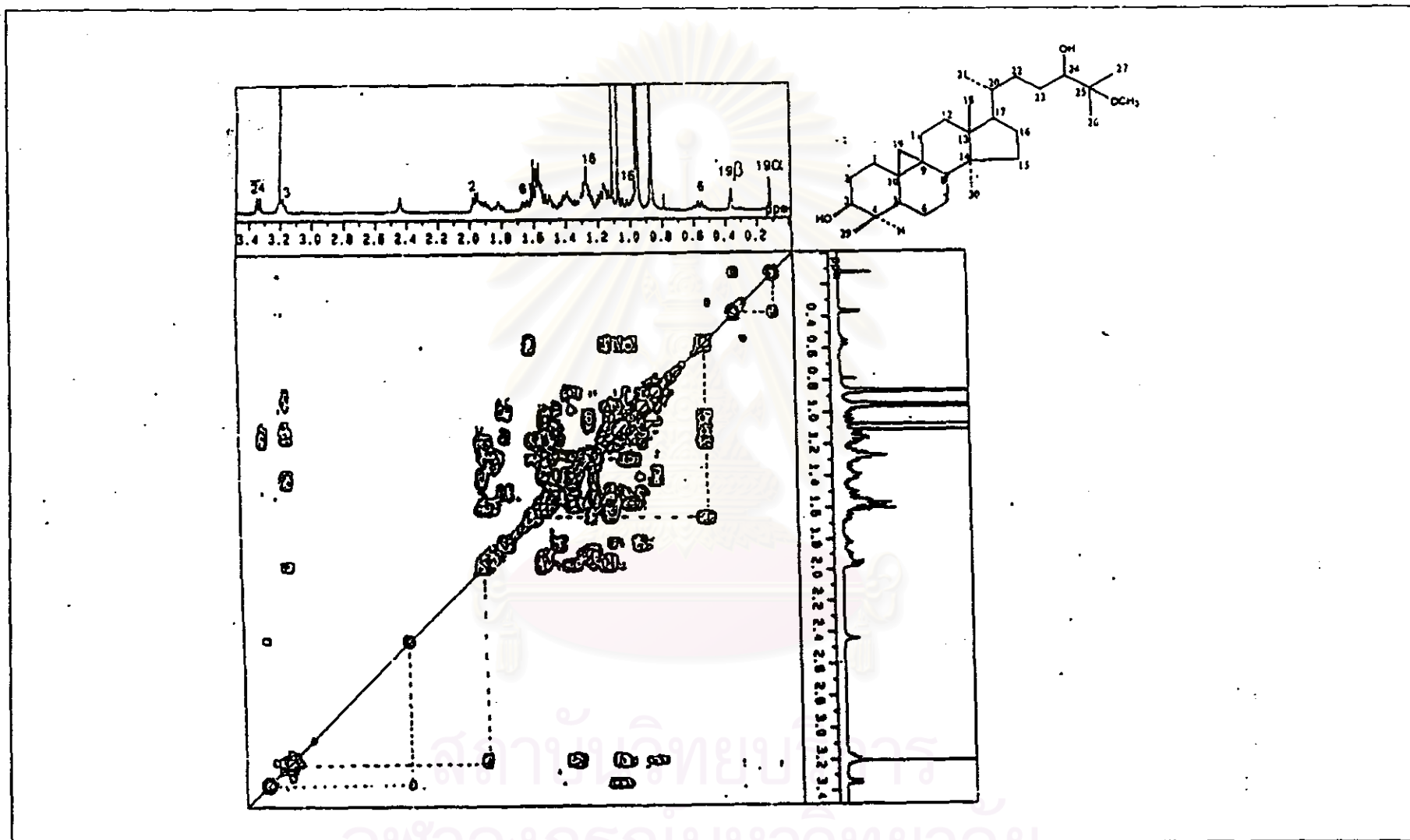


Figure 51 ^1H - ^1H COSY spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-3.4ppm and $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-3.4ppm)

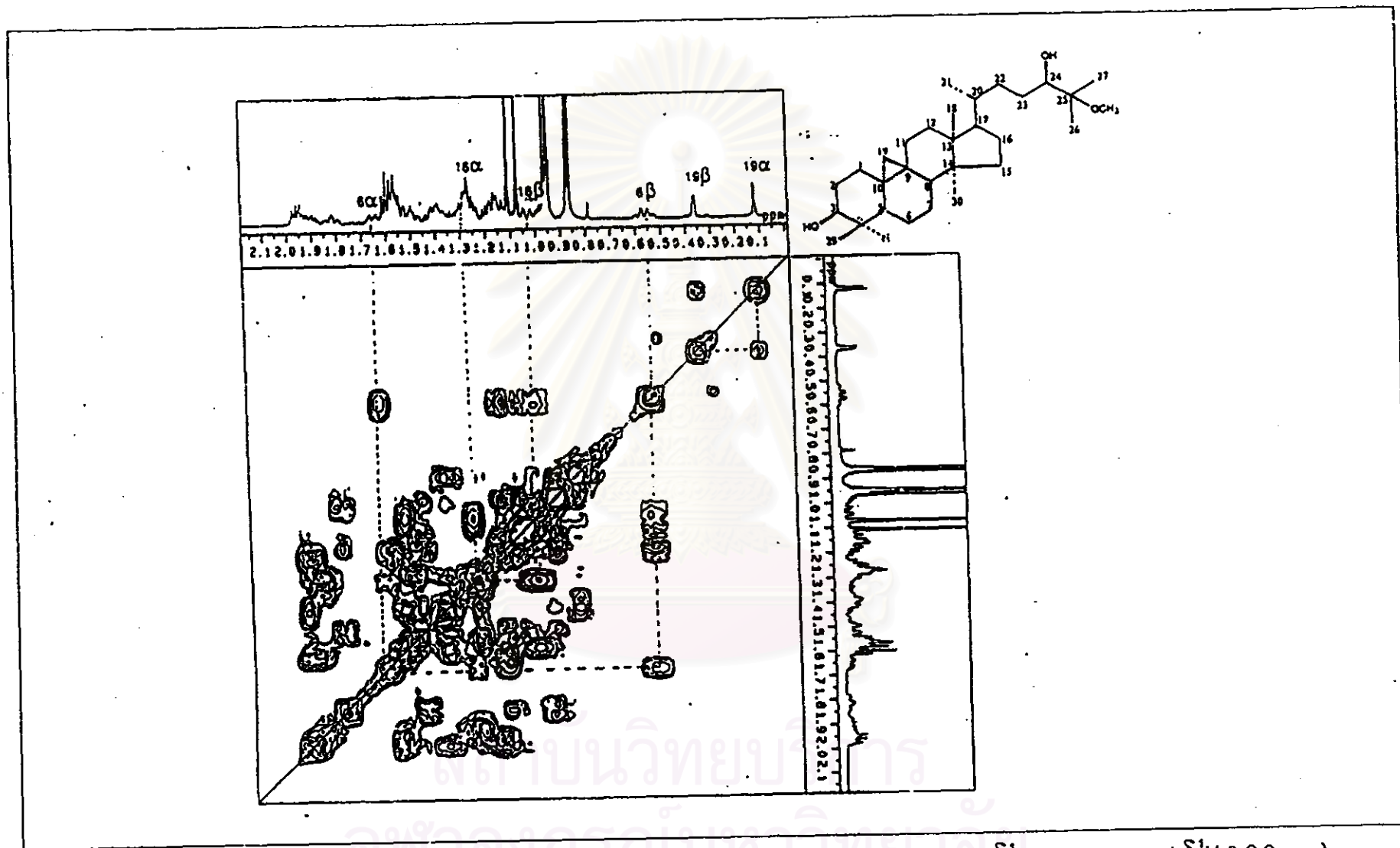


Figure 52 ^1H - ^1H COSY spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.2ppm and $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.2ppm)

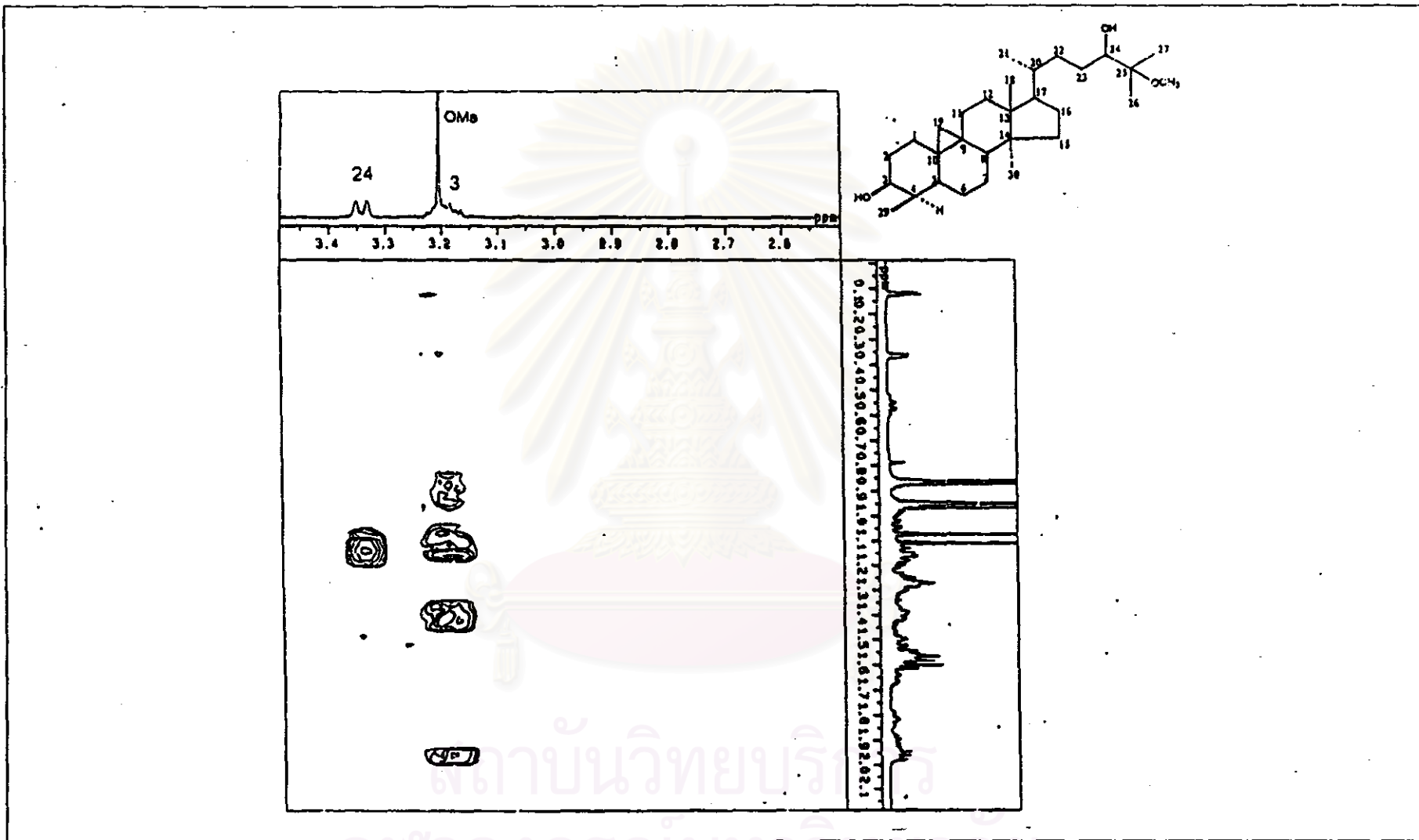


Figure 53 ^1H - ^1H COSY spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 2.5-3.5 ppm and $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.2ppm)

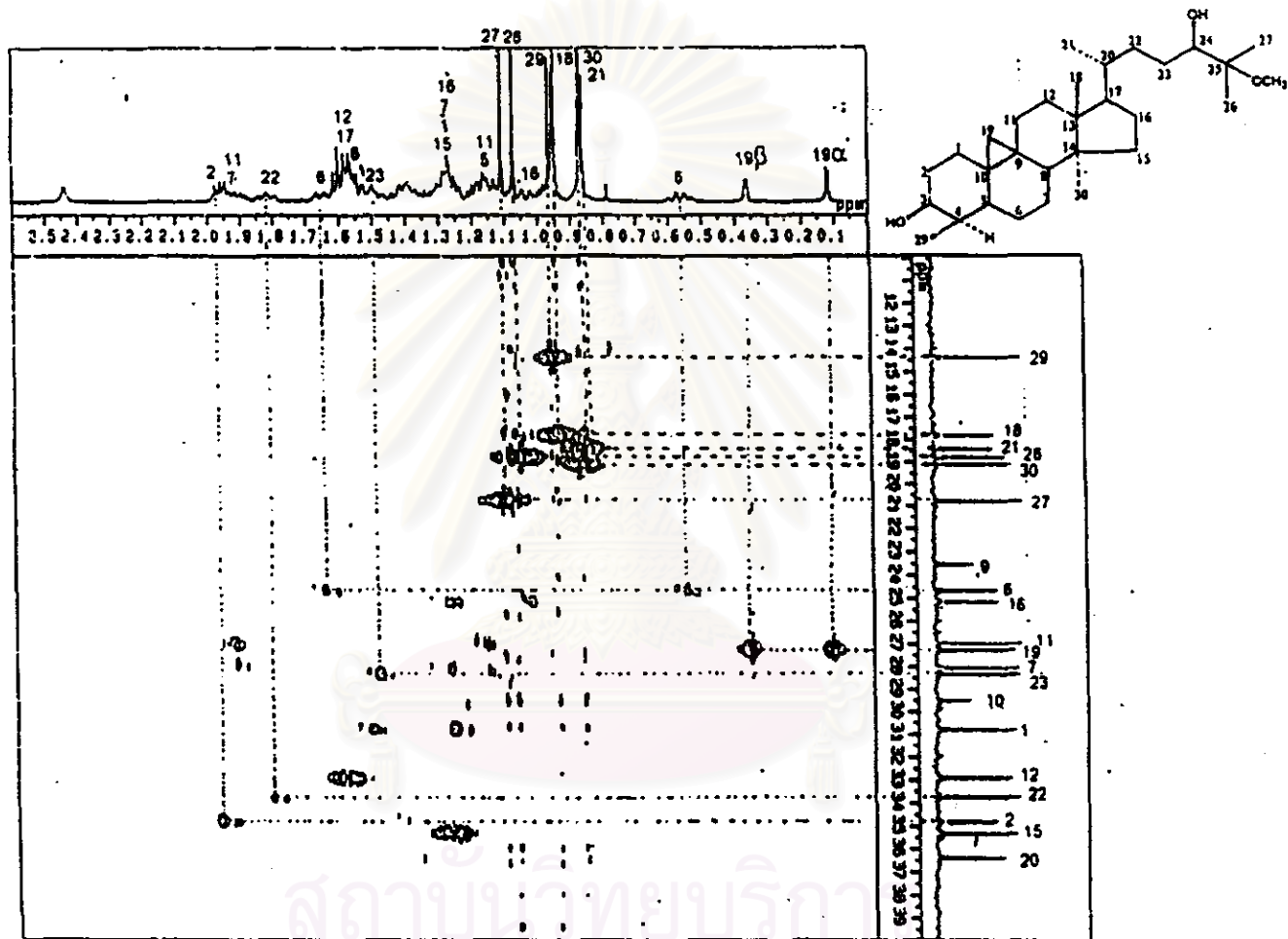


Figure 54 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.6 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 11-40 ppm)

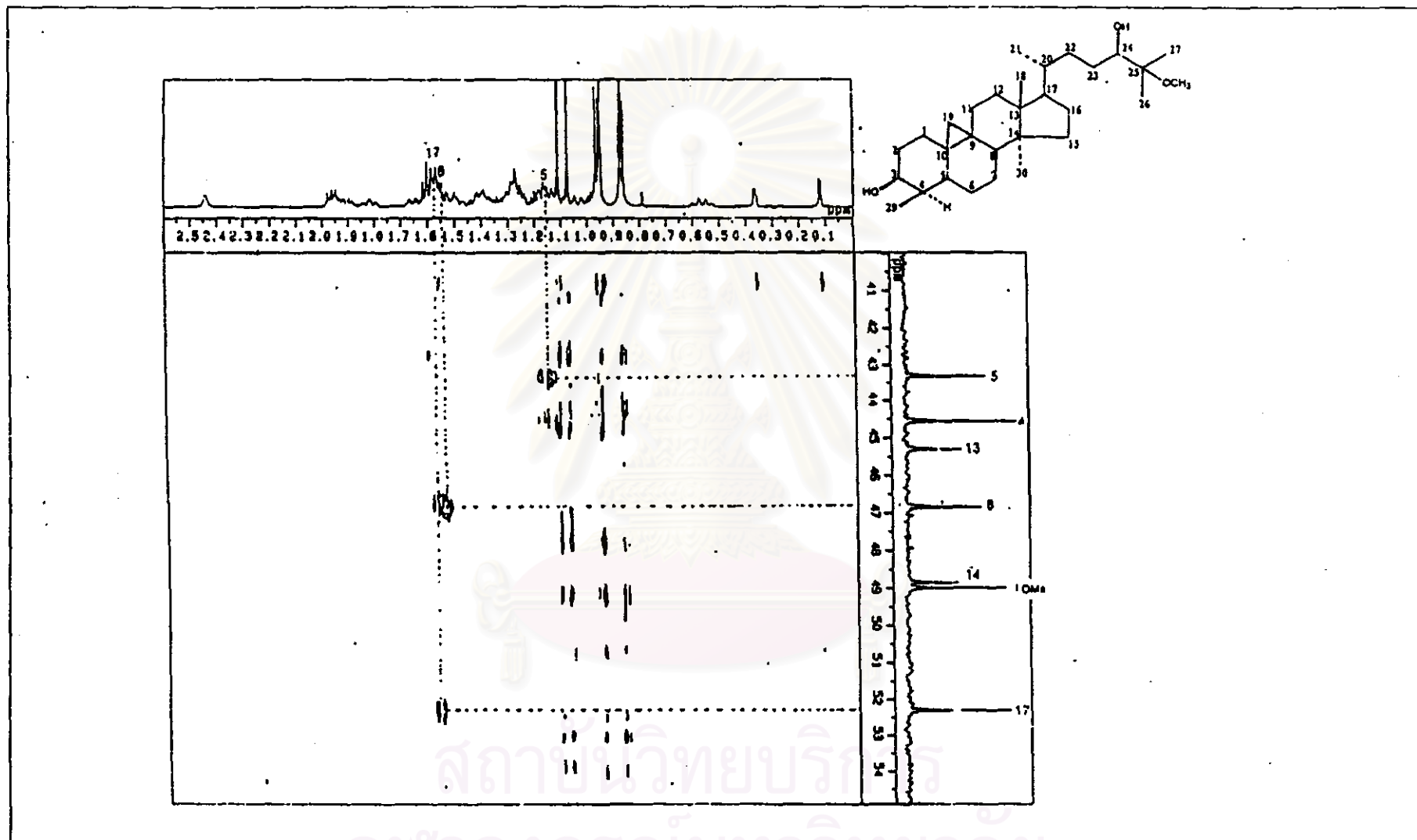


Figure 55 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 0-2.6 ppm and δ ^{13}C 40-55 ppm)

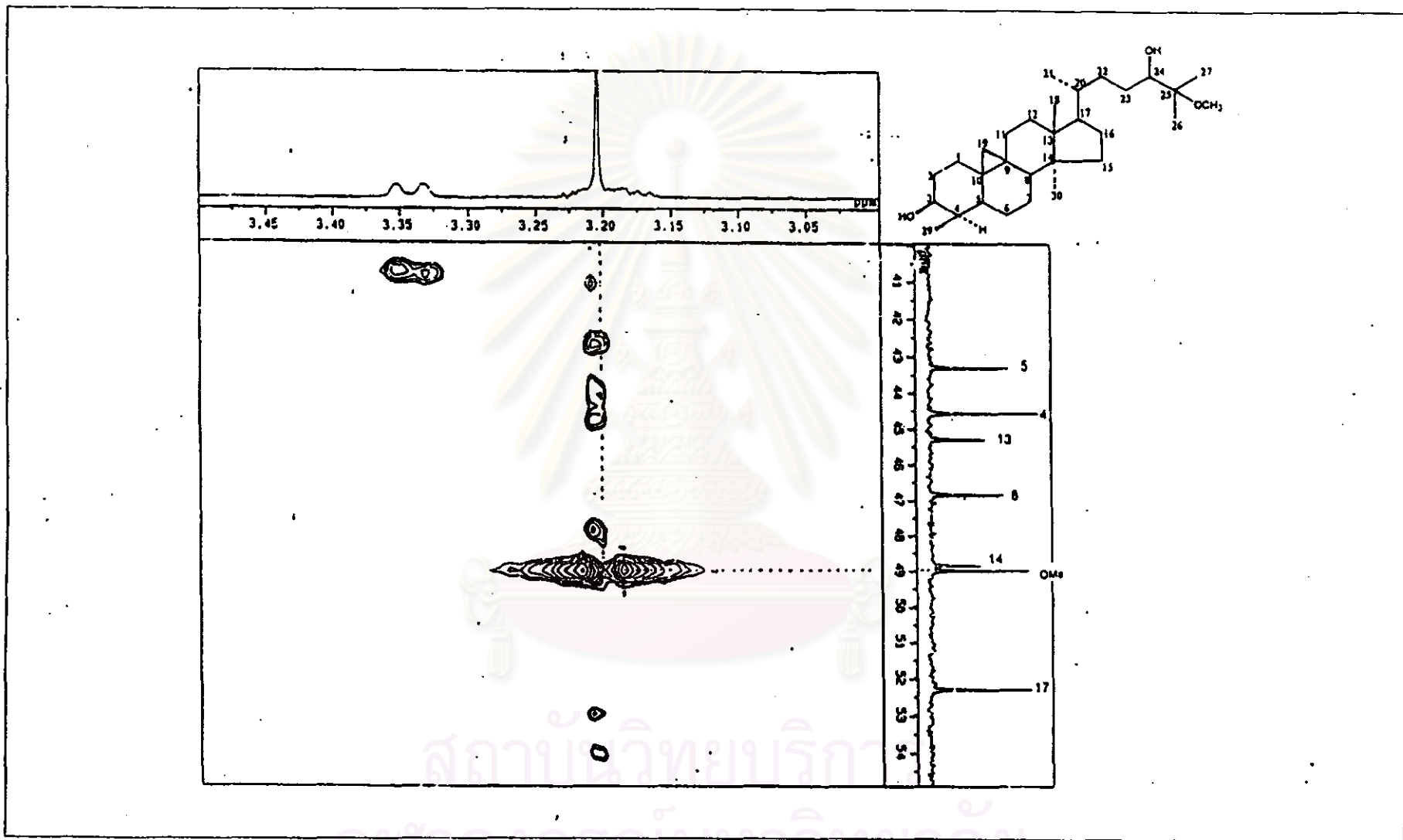


Figure 56 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 3.0-3.5 ppm and δ ^{13}C 40-55 ppm)

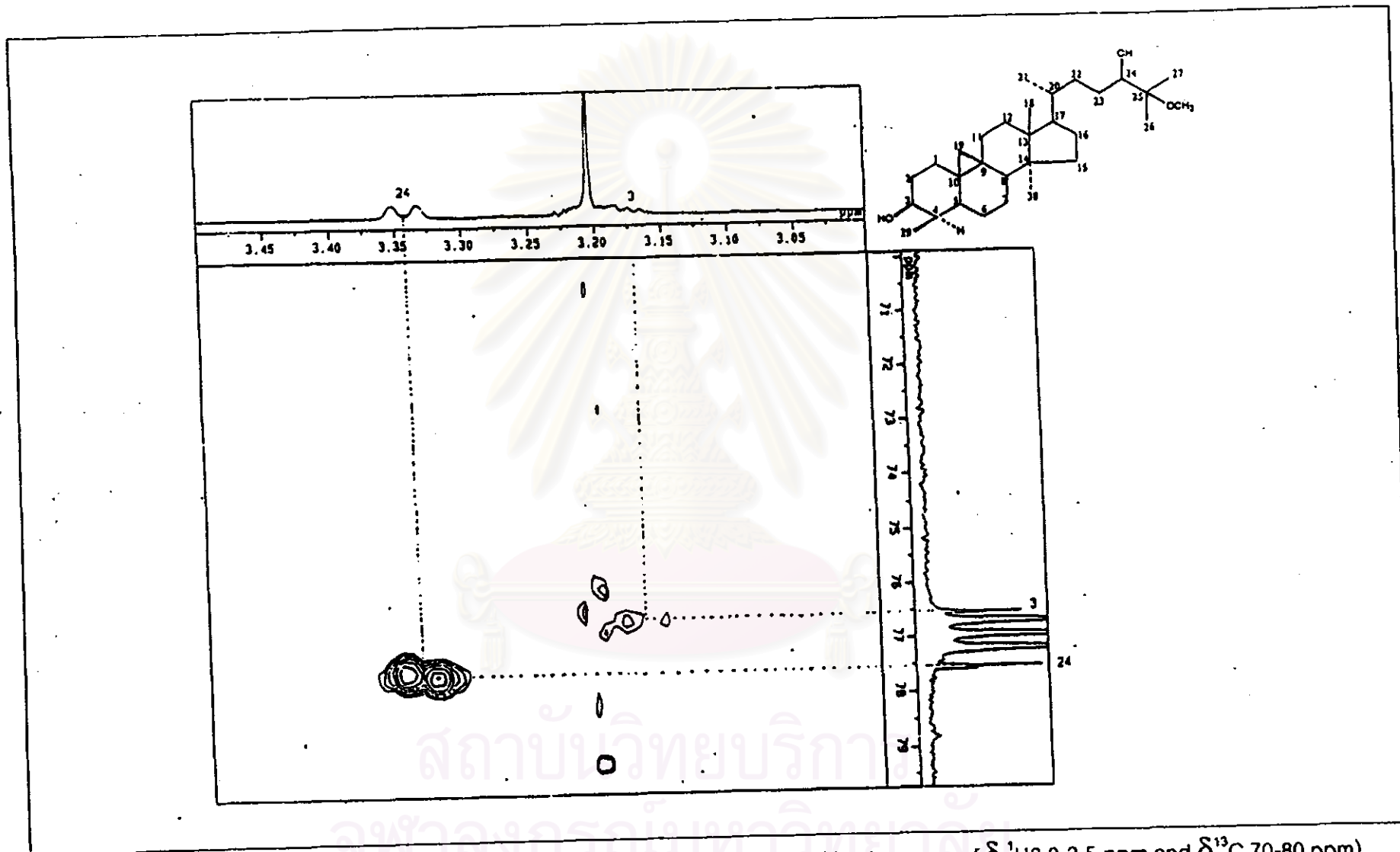


Figure 57 ^1H - ^{13}C HMQC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 3.0-3.5 ppm and δ ^{13}C 70-80 ppm)

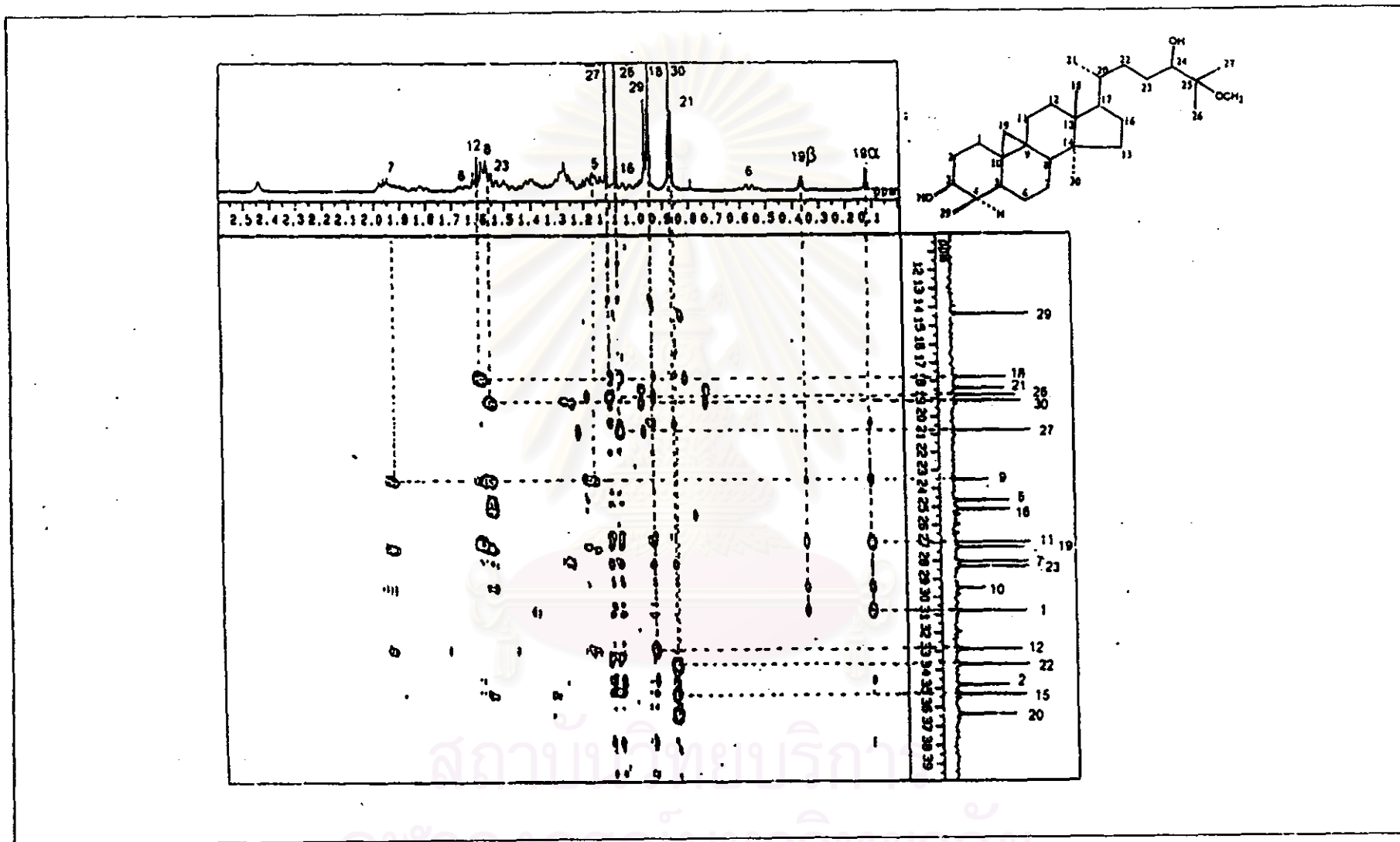


Figure 58 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.6 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 11-40 ppm)

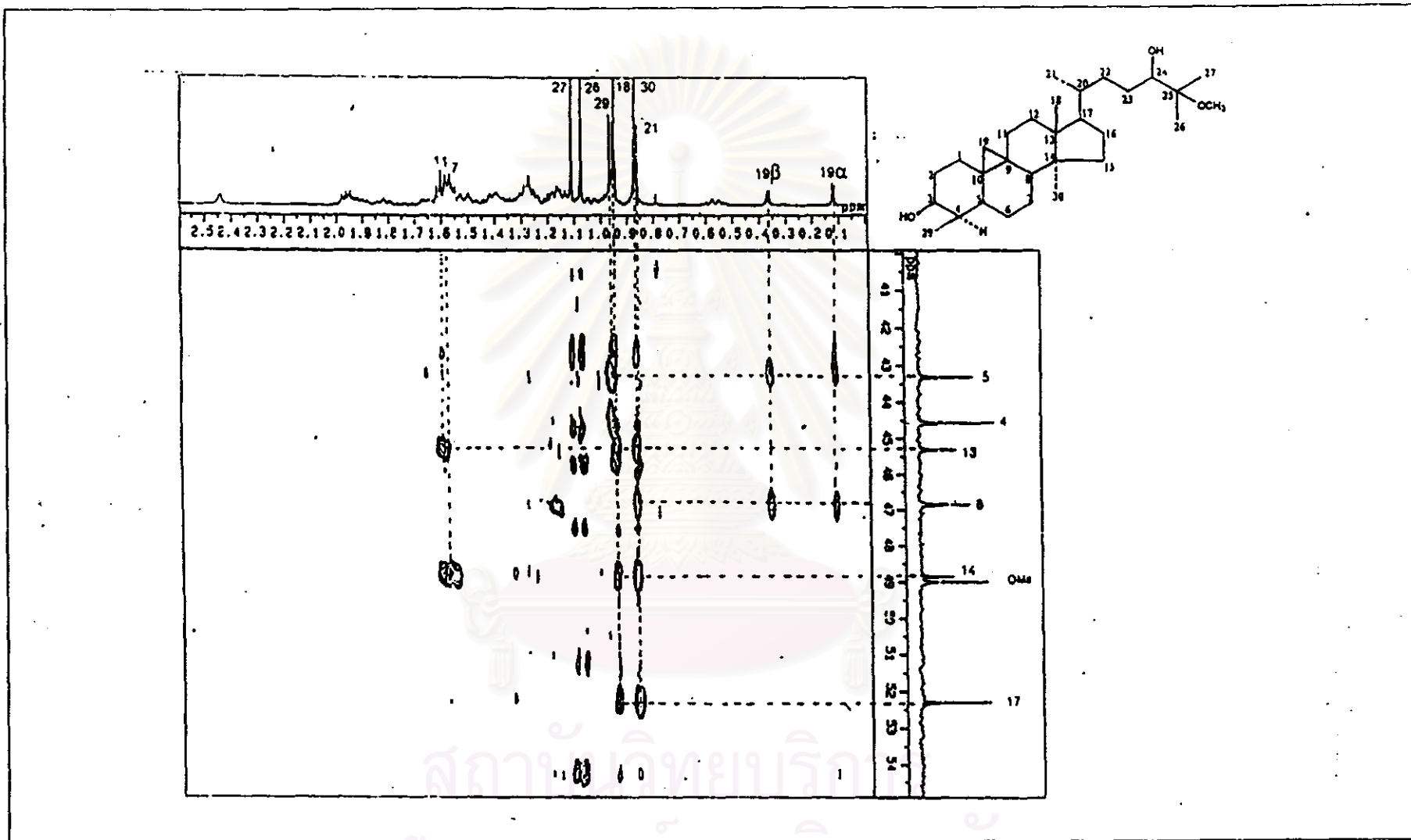


Figure 59 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 0-2.6 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 40-55 ppm)

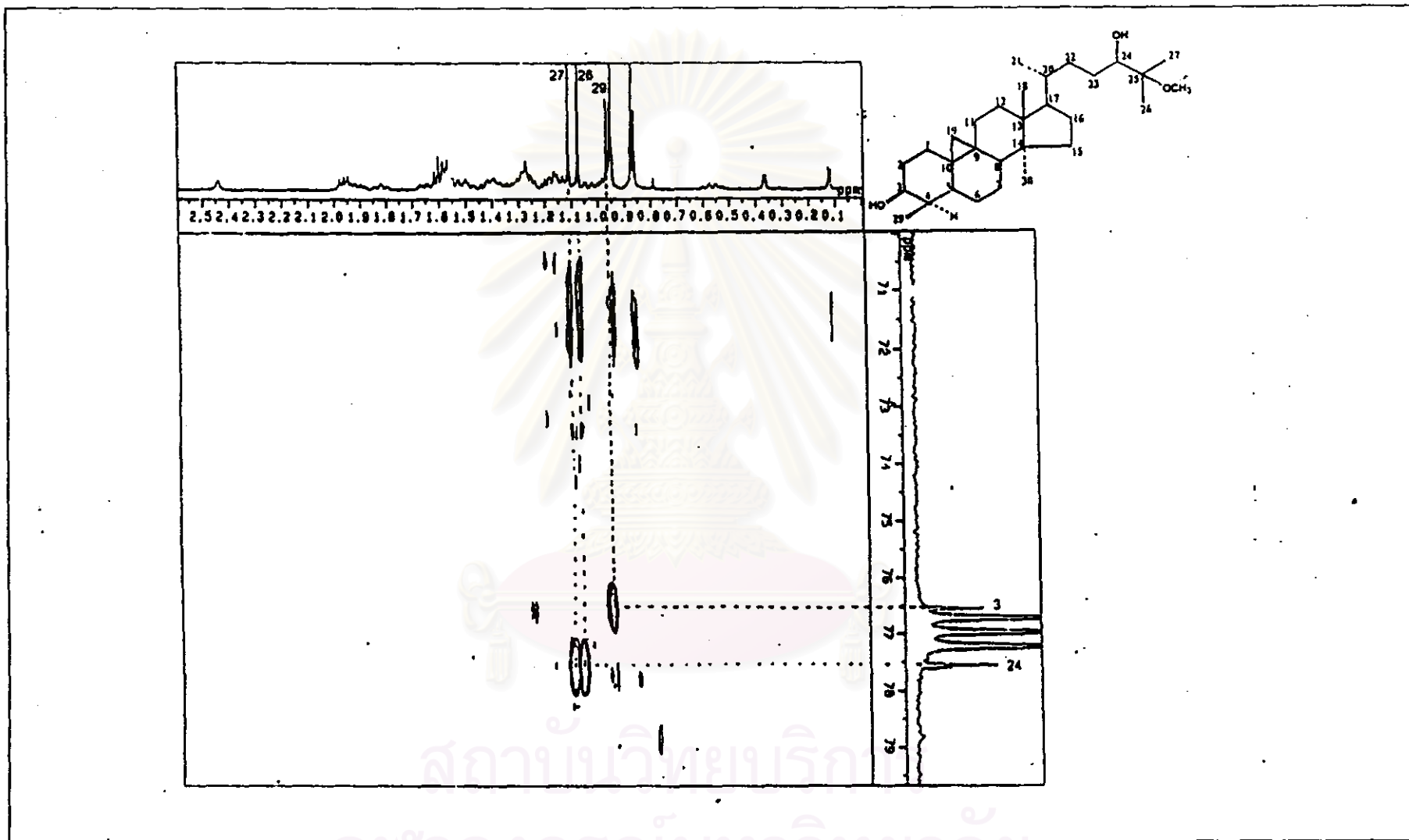


Figure 60 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of δ ^1H 0-2.6 ppm and δ ^{13}C 70-80 ppm)

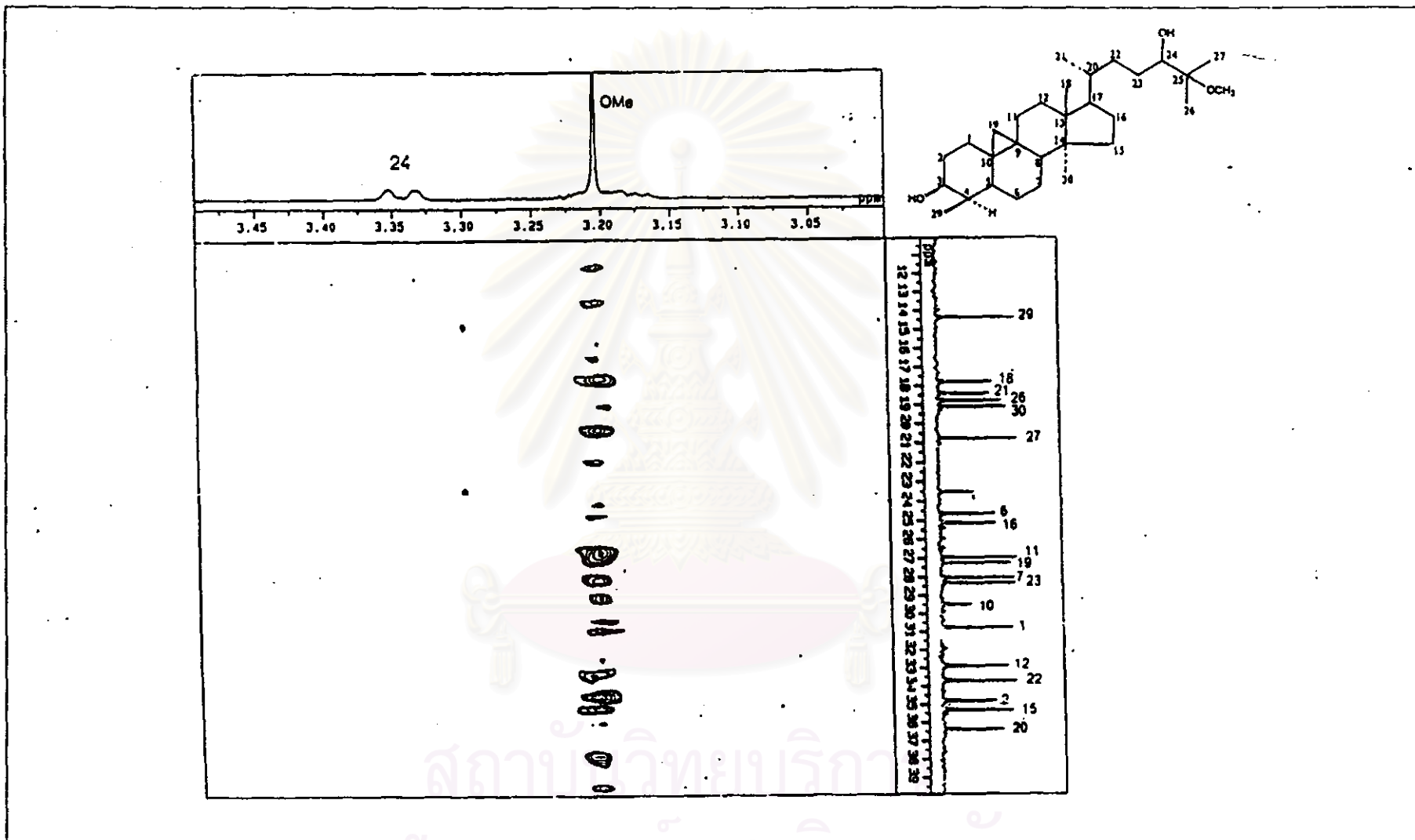


Figure 61 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 3.0-3.5 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 11-40 ppm)

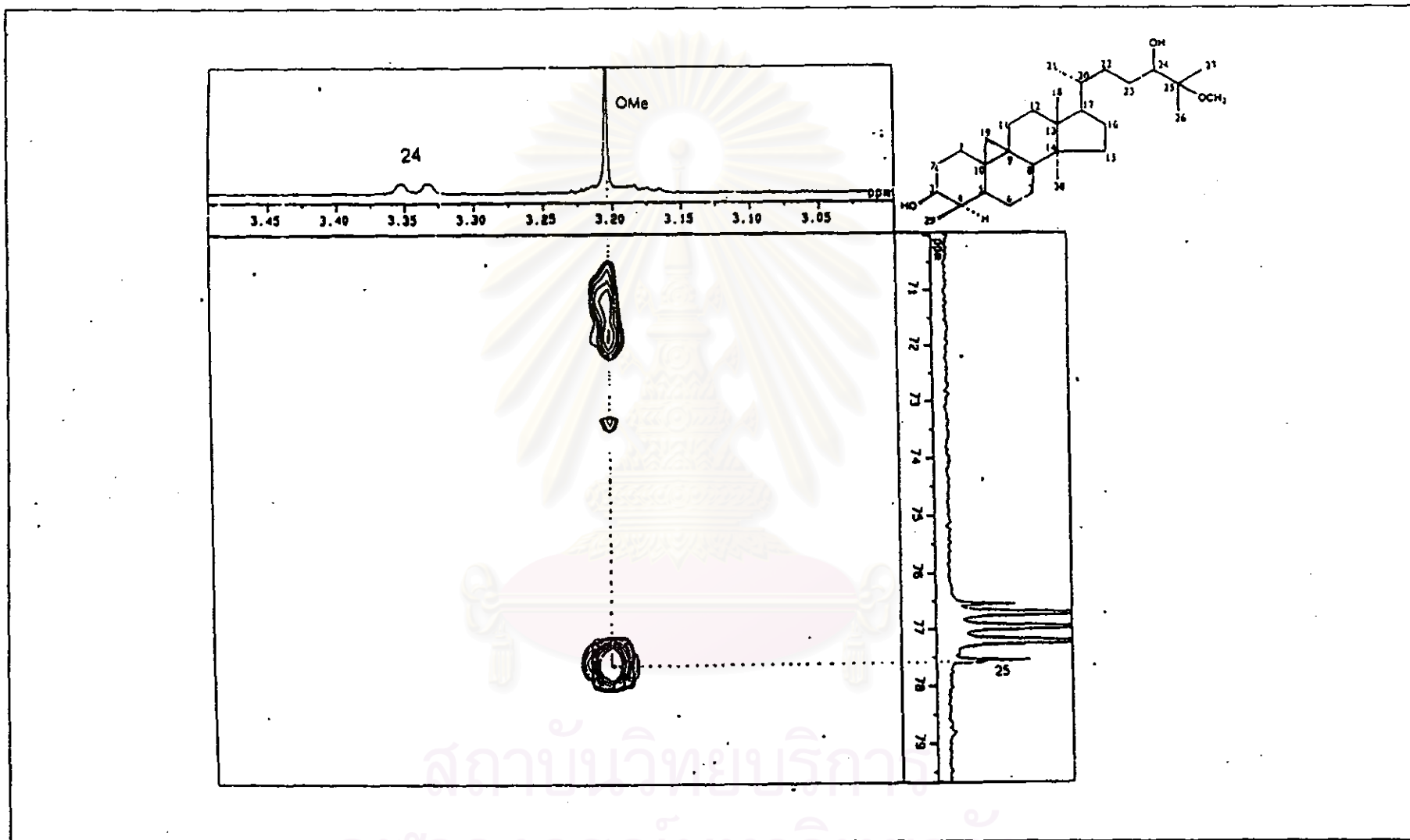


Figure 62 ^1H - ^{13}C HMBC spectrum of compound ACH3 (in CDCl_3) (expanded in the range of $\delta^1\text{H}$ 3.0-3.5 ppm and $\delta^{13}\text{C}$ 70-80 ppm)
