CHAPTER V

SUPPLIES

This study is the first effort to study responses of their college students to the Their version of the MMP1. The present study is based on the data derived from the Normative Croup. It also attempts to escourage further research and other projects focusing on the may to utilize this personality investory in Theiland

The susple of this study is a small group consisting of 56 first peop students at Chuleloopkoto University, during the scadente year of 1964-1965. They are divided into three groups, the Sangkok Group, the Province Group and the Nelo Group (the Male Group had to be emplosed due to the invalidity of the scares). The Province Group consists of 21 famels freshmen students who are residents of the university downtory and who cano from various provinces excluding Degukok and Dhomburt. The Sangkok Group is comprised of 19 first year students who are sarelied at the Faculty of Edgestion.

The That RPI, which was trapslated from the English MPI, was utilized to gave the responses from the sample. The subjects were ested to respond to each item eccarding to the directions given for the Morantivo Group in the United States.

The MPI keys which were validated in the Chited States were used to score the test support shorts. Then the mean score profiles of each group mere drama and presented, each profile showing fourteen scales, including both validity scales and clinical scales. In addition to the mean scores presented in profile form, individual scores are presented in

The elgoificant test was used to determine the eignificant differences between the percentages of true responses of the two groups. The comparisons of percentages of true responses on each scale were presented in Table form.

The findings of this study may be summerized as follows:

- I) North of the most ecores so the fourteen seeles of the Fraviote Group and the Sangkok Group are in the normal range when compared with the case scores on each scole for the Simmerofa Normative Group. Only the Scorelo or Scole 8 of the Cangkok Group is higher then 70 T seems points.

 Then comparing the scores of the Province Group with the scores of the Cangkok Group scale by scale, the result is that most scales of the Cangkok Group bad higher scores than the Province Group, except in the Mf scale and the Se scale. The highest difference in T score points is 7 which is found on the Pd scale.
- 2) All of the profile bare the highest peet on the Se scale (Scale 0) is followed by the D scale (Scale 0).
- 3) There is a significant difference between the number of tespontes of the Province Group and those of the Benginsk Group on Items 17, 73, 111, 154, 160, 201, 240, 240, and 257.

Proposed for further studies.

In the discussion of the findings of the study none suggestions for further study were made by the writer. It may prove worthwile to temporize these as follows:

1. A diplication of this study chould be doze using a larger sample which will adequately represent the cellege student papelation.

- 2. The same type of study could be carried out for the purpose of comparing the Seited States College Group and the Taul College Group.
- 3. The process of velidesing this investory in Testlesd aboutd be derived out which will lead to the development of keys velideted in this country. Thes, and only then, the interpretations of individual and group accres can be made.
