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The meaning of older age

- Process of progressive change in the biological, psychological and social structure of an individual.
- Life long process, which begins before we are born and continuous throughout life (Claudia, 1999).
- Definition of elder used in this study is the chronological of <u>SIXTY and OVER</u>, which are men or women and equivalent to older people or aging

Quality of life (QOL)

- <u>WHO</u> defined for QOL as individuals' perception on their position in life in the context of the culture and value systems in which the live and in relation to their goals, expectation, standard and concerns

WHOOOL-100 development

- QOL definition and approach to international QOL assessment

- 100 items were selected for inclusion in the WHOQOL-100 Field Trial Version.

 To inform decision making in term of policy, health promotion and social services.


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Specific objectives
